DISCIPLINARY ACTION, FIRST QUARTER 2007:

COMPLAINANT: Internal

ALLEGATION/S: Alleged violation of NRS 625.520(1)

SUMMARY: Stamped and signed plans, drawings and

calculations which contained matters outside of

the discipline of civil engineering.

STATUS: Accepted a Stipulated Agreement to pay investigative cost in the amount of \$280 and administrative fine of \$250. Mr. Taube shall notify his clients for whom he performed mechanical engineering services that plans, drawings and calculations arguably contained matters outside of his licensed discipline of civil engineering. Mr. Taube shall be issued a public reprimand and agrees not to apply for licensure as a professional engineer in the State of Nevada for a period of not less than five years commencing on March 31, 2007.

details, designs, plans, drawings and calculations for Nye County Emergency Services Power Plan using his Nevada State

Civil Engineering stamp.

STATUS: Accepted a stipulated agreement to pay investigative cost of \$650 and be issued a public reprimand.

RESPONDENT: Mark R. Allocco COMPLAINANT: Marc Adams

ALLEGATION/S: Violation of NRS 625

SUMMARY: Mr. Allocco is not licensed as a professional

engineer or land surveyor in the State of

Nevada. Mr. Allocco falsely represented himself

to be a licensed professional engineer and received in excess of \$6,300 from innocent residents of this State who believed Mr. Allocco

was licensed. The State Board filed its

complaint against Mr. Allocco in the Second

Iudicial District Court of Nevada.

STATUS: The Court found in favor of the Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors and entitled judgment enjoining Mark R. Allocco from performing to perform professional engineering services in the State of Nevada. Additionally, the State Board was entitled to judgment against Mark R. Allocco in the amount of \$1.332.
