close cooperation with FEMA and Clark County Developmental Services to insure both agencies are aware that some of the flood control facilities were not constructed; provide the Executive Director with copies of the notifications sent to FEMA and Clark County by October 1, 2004; pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$250; reimbursement to the Board of investigative costs in the amount of \$1,250, payable in equal monthly installments of \$100 beginning on October 1, 2004; and be issued a public reprimand.
