The mentoring program will provide that he not solicit engineering work involving structures during the period of probation; submit quarterly reports to the Executive Director of the State Board setting forth the nature and scope of the work performed by him during the term of his probation. The reports must include a reviewing structural engineer's report. He shall pay all costs for review of this structural work; and successful completion of continuing education on matters involving structures.
