DISCIPLINARY ACTION, FOURTH QUARTER 2006:

SUMMARY: Performed a field survey and did not perform the required fieldwork.
STATUS: Accepted a Stipulated Agreement to suspend licensee for two (2) years, stayed, with probation for the same two-year period; submit reports setting forth the nature and scope of land surveying work performed during probation; submit names of three Nevada land surveyors who are willing to review his work with the cost to be paid by him; successfully complete a college level course in boundary control and legal principles including ethics components within one year; successfully complete the Nevada specific land surveying exam within 6 months; and reimburse the Board its investigative costs in the amount of \$500 within 30 days.
