Attached, please find the Board's Biennial Reports for July 1, 2000 – June 30, 2002 and July 1, 2002 – June 30, 2004, as submitted to the Governor's Office last year.

In addition, here, in summary, is the required information for the biennium ending June 30, 2004.

#### NRS 622,100

No disciplinary actions were initiated for the first quarter of 2005.

- 1. Number of licenses issued for the biennium ending June 30, 2004: 7 (Note: This was a significant event, in that it represented a net positive number in our registration rolls. Due to Board activity in the past biennium, the current list of registrants is at 48, an increase of 60% since July 1, 2002.
- 2. Budget summary and Income and Expenditure Report: You have seen the budget for the current biennium, developed and submitted by Mr. Daniel Maxson, and presented in evidence during testimony before the Senate Commerce and Labor Committee. Prior to that time, as required, Mr. Maxson did submit an Income and Expenditure Report as required, in a timely manner.
- 3. There were no complaints registered with respect to our Registered Environmental Health Specialists in the biennium ending June 30, 2004, and no disciplinary action initiated. This is to
