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## QUARTERLY DISCIPLINARY REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL BUREAU

## **JANUARY 20, 2008**

1. Michael Szewczyk CVS #2989

Board Meeting 10/24/07

Case No. 06-071-RPH-S

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Patient C took two prescriptions to CVS #2989 to be filled. One was a new prescription for gemfibrozil and the other was for a hydrocortisone cream that he had used before but not for some time. When Patient C arrived home he noticed that the expiration date on the prescription label for the hydrocortisone cream was November 20, 2007 even though the manufacturer's date was September 20, 2007. It was determined that the default date in CVS computers is one year and that date is automatically printed on the label. Patient C was not counseled when he picked up his prescriptions.

Mr. Szewczyk was fined \$100.00 for the error and \$750.00 for failure to counsel. CVS #2989 was placed on probation for one year, fined \$750 and pay the Board's fees and costs in this matter.

Legal counsel for the Board and CVS signed a stipulated agreement that these cases would be the same as the orders for the first cases heard regarding technicians working without licenses in June. Ms. Kinan did not fulfill her obligation from the last Board Order to have a complete psychiatric evaluation. Ms. Kinan was also released from the PRN-PRN program since she was not fulfilling her obligation to the program and

she owed a considerable amount of money. Ms. Kinan's pharmacist license was revoked.

Ms. Vioga advised Board staff that she did not want a hearing and she did not appear. Ms. Vioga admitted in her Answer and Notice of Defense to taking ten bottles of hydrocodone 10/325 from her employing pharmacy during the course of a three month period. Ms. Vioga's PT registration was revoked.

6 Shara J. Jamieson Board Meeting 10/24/07 Case No. 07-032-PT-S

Ms. Jamieson did not contest the charges that she had taken Dilaudid, morphine, Percocet, and Lortab from her employing pharmacy. Ms. Jamieson testified that she was taking the drugs for her personal use and that she hadn't used drugs since the day she left her employing pharmacy. When asked if she went into a treatment program to withdraw, Ms. Jamieson said she had not but she felt tired for a couple of days. Ms. Jamieson's pharmaceutical technician registration was revoked.
