This is the Private Investigator's Licensing Board compliance summary that was mandated under Senate Bill No. 420.

The Private Investigative Licensing Board is the regulatory board for licensing Private Investigator's, Private Patrolman, Process Servers, Repossessors, Canine Handlers and Polygraph Examiners. The authority for this Board is NRS (Nevada Revised Statute) 648 and NAC (Nevada Administrative Code) 648.

The quarterly meeting for the Board was held June 5, 2001. The Board agenda did not reflect disciplinary action be taken against any licensee. However, the Board does have the authority to cite for unlicensed activity and at the June 5, 2001, meeting it was reflected on the agenda that a Mr. William Brooks and Mr. Fred Del Marva, had requested to appear before the Board at an appeal hearing for the issuance of an unlicensed activity fine. It was requested and granted that both hearings be held over until the September meeting.

The quarterly meeting for the Board was held September 6, 2001. The Board agenda did not reflect disciplinary action be taken against any licensee. However, the Board did hear an unlicensed activity appeal from Mr. Fred Del Marva. The Board upheld the unlicensed activity citation issued to Mr. Del Marva and he was charged a fine of \$2500.00 By letter, Mr. Del Marva requested to make his payment in five monthly installments. The Executive Director for the Board accepted his request.
