The purpose of this letter is to comply with NRS 622.100, which requires occupational licensing Boards to submit quarterly reports of disciplinary action, during the preceding quarter (January 1, 2005 through March 31, 2005). The Board of Psychological Examiners dismissed three (3) complaints and formally voted to accept two settlement agreement orders in which licenses were surrendered, without going to a hearing. During the first quarter of this calendar year the Board's records reflect the receipt of two (2) new complaints. There are a total of 14 pending complaints.
