9	The State of Nevada Board of Examiners for Social Workers ("BOARD") having
10	jurisdiction over licensee CHARLES RAY HARE ("HARE"), pursuant to NRS 641B.020;
1	accusations against said licensee having been received alleging violations of the Nevada
12	statutes and regulations controlling the practice of social work; and the parties being mutually
13	desirous of settling the controversy between them relative to the pending accusations;
14	T IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED between the undersigned parties that this
15	matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:
16	VOLUNTARY WAIVER OF RIGHTS
17	HARE is aware of, understands, and has been advised of the effect of this Consent
18	Decree, which he has carefully read and fully acknowledges. HARE has had the opportunity
19	to consult with competent counsel of his choice.

HARE has freely and voluntarily entered into this Consent Decree, and he is aware of his rights to contest the charges pending against him. These rights include representation by an attorney at his own expense, the right to file an answer in response to a formal complaint, the right to a public hearing on any charges or allegations formally filed, the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses called to testify against him, the right to present evidence on his own behalf, the right to testify on his own behalf, the right to receive written findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting the decision on the merits of the complaint, and the right to obtain judicial review of the decision All of these rights are being voluntarily waived by HARE in exchange for the BOARD'S acceptance of this Consent Decree.

If the Consent Decree is not accepted by the BOARD, no member of the BOARD will be disqualified from further hearing of this matter, by reason of his or her consideration of the Consent Decree and HARE hereby waives any claim of bias or prejudice based upon said consideration by any member of the BOARD in any subsequent disciplinary hearing conducted by the BOARD.

## **JURISDICTION**

HARE acknowledges that the BOARD has jurisdiction over him and the conduct that has precipitated this Consent Decree. HARE acknowledges that the BOARD has the legal power and authority to take disciplinary action, including, but not limited to, the revocation of his license to practice social work in Nevada.

HARE acknowledges that the BOARD will retain jurisdiction over this matter until all terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Decree have been met to the satisfaction of the BOARD.

# PUBLICATION OF CONSENT DECREE

HARE acknowledges that at the time this Consent Decree becomes effective, it also becomes a public document and will be reported to the Disciplinary Action Reporting System (DARS) of the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB) or such other national databases as required by law. It is also understood that the meeting in which the BOARD considers and accepts or rejects this Consent Decree is open to the public and that the minutes of the BOARD meeting are a public document, available for inspection by any person so requesting.

## STIPULATED FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

HARE understands the nature of the allegations under consideration by the BOARD. He acknowledges that the conduct described below constitutes violations of the Nevada Social Work Practice Act (NRS and NAC 641B). He acknowledges that if this matter were to be taken to a disciplinary hearing before the BOARD, the following allegations could be proven by substantial evidence and that by acknowledging the same, he is subject to disciplinary action by the BOARD:

HARE stipulates that pursuant to the authority of NRS 641B.430(3) and (4), the BOARD will impose a revocation of HARE's LSW license by the voluntary surrender by HARE of his license to the BOARD. Upon the surrender of the LSW license, HARE agrees to comply with the following conditions:

- 1 Within ninety (90) days of the approval and execution of this Consent Decree, HARE shall pay \$500.00 in legal and investigative fees
- 2. The revocation shall commence upon execution of this Consent Decree by the presiding member of the BOARD. HARE may not apply for any social work license in this

1 State during the period this consent decree is in effect. After the revocation has been in 2 effect for a one-year time period, HARE may apply for re-instatement of his LSW or apply for 3 a new license level to the BOARD. If HARE re-applies for any social work license in this State, he agrees to 4 5 а Meet with the President of the BOARD or his/her designee, the Executive 6 Director and BOARD counsel and prove compliance with the Consent Decree 7 and fitness for licensure b. 8 Provide proof to the BOARD from a BOARD approved forensic 9 psychiatrist or forensic psychologist that he is competent to act as a social 10 worker. 11 3. After his license is reinstated, HARE stipulates that pursuant to the authority of 12 NRS 641B.430(3)(a), the BOARD may impose a one (1) year period of probation upon his 13 license to practice social work in the State of Nevada subject to the following terms and conditions 14 15 a. HARE meets monthly with a BOARD approved licensed clinical social 16 worker who will consult with HARE During this period of consultation, HARE will write, and 17 the supervisor will sign quarterly reports that must be submitted to the BOARD regarding 18 HARE's counseling sessions Issues to be discussed in the monthly meeting and addressed in the report to the Board must include 19 20 (i) Boundaries and dual relationships: 21 (ii) Review of judgment skills and decision-making abilities; 22 (iii) Professional responsibilities to clients and colleagues; and 23 The obligations and risks associated with the provisions of social (iv) 24 work services. 25 b. HARE shall obey all federal, state and local laws, insurance company 26 policies or contracts and orders of the BOARD, which are not inconsistent with this Consent 27 Decree, pertaining to the practice of social work in this State. Any and all violations shall be

reported by HARE to the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours

- c HARE is required to notify the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after any change in social work employment, including self-employment, consulting or volunteering. Any notification of termination shall contain a full explanation of the circumstances surrounding it.
- d HARE is required to notify the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after any change in social work employment, including self-employment, consulting or volunteering. Any notification of termination shall contain a full explanation of the circumstances surrounding it
- e HARE shall receive credit toward service of his probation period only while employed as a Licensed Social Worker in the State of Nevada
- f. HARE shall notify all current and potential employers of any term or condition of probation which will affect his employment. HARE shall provide a copy of the consent decree to each employer during the length of probation. Such notification shall be signed by each employer. HARE shall submit, upon request by the BOARD or its designee, satisfactory evidence of compliance with this term of probation.
- 4 HARE agrees that he will be financially responsible for all requirements of this Consent Decree, including the cost of the Board approved forensic psychiatric evaluation and any reasonable financial assessments by the Board for the Cost of monitoring his compliance or carrying out the provisions of this Consent Decree

## VIOLATION OF TERMS OF CONSENT DECREE

HARE understands that the BOARD may, upon three days notice to HARE, convene a hearing for the limited purpose of establishing that he has, in fact, been in violation of the terms of this Consent Decree If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Consent Decree, the BOARD may impose any penalty upon HARE authorized by NRS 641B.430(3), and (4) including, but not limited to, revocation of her license to practice social work in the State of Nevada

In the event that a violation of the terms of the Consent Decree is alleged, HARE agrees to surrender his license to the Executive Director, if the Executive Director so

requests, and refrain from practicing social work until entry of a final order of the BOARD or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding a potential violation HARE agrees to waive his right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the original disciplinary action, which is the basis for this Consent Decree In the event an alleged violation of the Consent Decree is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the BOARD and the suspension previously ordered by the BOARD shall again be operative and in full force and effect.

## ACCEPTANCE BY THE BOARD

This Consent Decree was presented and accepted by the BOARD with a recommendation for approval from the Attorney General's Office at its next meeting.
