1 James Sapp, DVM March 27-28, 2003 Board Meeting #01-011003-194

A consumer complaint was filed with the Board on January 10, 2003. The complaint was investigated and it was determined that Dr. Sapp was practicing veterinary medicine without a license in a facility that was not registered with the Board. It was determined that Dr. Sapp had violated the provisions of Chapter 638 in that the Licensee's conduct violated NRS 638.170, & 638.0603, practicing veterinary medicine without a license and providing veterinary services in a facility that in not registered with the Board. The licensee agreed to a Consent Decree that states that Dr. Sapp cannot apply for reinstatement of his license for a period of five years.

2. James Reilly, DVM March 27-28-2003 Board Meeting #01-012303-729

The Board filed a complaint on January 23, 2003. The complaint was filed as a result of a hospital inspection that indicated several violations of Chapter 638. A re-inspection was done within 30 days of the January inspection indicating that medical records were still not being maintained within the provisions of NRS 638.037. Dr. Reilly entered into a Consent Decree with the Board agreeing to: 1) 2 year probation; 2) Quarterly hospital inspections for the period of the probation; and 3) pay the costs of conducting the inspections.
