SENATE BILL 409

Revises provisions relating to animals.

INTRODUCTORY REMARKS:

Thank you, (Mr./Madam) President. Do we recognize the threat to pets left in an unattended motor vehicle? Senate Bill 409 provides that certain public employees and volunteers whose work relates to animals or public safety may use any reasonable means necessary to protect a pet and remove it from an unattended vehicle. The bill also requires peace officers and animal control officers to take possession of an animal that is being treated cruelly, and it authorizes them to take possession of an animal that is being used in fights with other animals.
