SENATE BILL 413

Establishes “Public Lands Day” in the State of Nevada.

INTRODUCTORY REMARKS:

Thank you, (Mr./Madam) President. Recognizing the both importance, uniqueness and value of public lands in this State and building on the federal Public Lands Day tradition, Senate Bill 413 declares the last Saturday of each September to be “Public Lands Day” in Nevada.

The bill requests the Governor to issue a proclamation every year promoting the day and, as an added perk, we have companion measure in the Assembly that directs the Division of State Parks to waive entry, camping and boating fees in State parks and recreational areas on Public Lands Day.
