Take on the role of a Senator, the Lieutenant Governor or the Secretary of the Senate and learn how they work together to ensure a well-run Senate Floor Session.



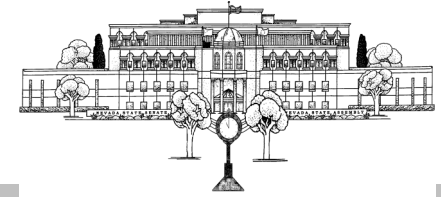
Debate Bills!

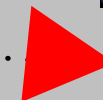
Cast Your Vote!
