The Nevada Senate's Simulation Experience

SENATORS

- You represent your fellow Nevadans. The decisions you make will affect them directly. Be judicious when casting your vote.
- Names of Senators with speaking roles are noted in red text and "stage directions" are noted in purple text. If you do not have an assigned speaking role, you are welcome and encouraged to speak when each bill or resolution comes up for debate.
- You may only speak when recognized by the President. Request to speak by pushing the orange SPK button at your desk. You will be recognized in the order of your request. Senators who have not yet spoken will be recognized before those who wish to speak a second time.
- When you are recognized, stand and pick up the handheld microphone next to your desk. The white MIC button on your desk is activated by the President. If the microphone is not on, push the white MIC button to activate.
- Bill and Resolution Sponsors will read the floor statements at their desks as part of the script. This will be a brief speech in favor of the passage of the bill or resolution. Because you have been assigned the role of the Sponsor, your remarks are in support of the bill or resolution, no matter your personal feelings on the topic.
- Vote on the three measures today by selecting either the green YEA button or red NAY button at your desk when asked to do so by the President. The vote will be displayed on the Chamber's video screen.
- Please keep the simulation moving forward by not proposing amendments or by making motions not included in the script.
- Have fun, do not be shy and participate! Only your active involvement can make this simulation a success.
