PROPOSED PERMANENT REGULATIONS OF THE
NEVADA STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

Petition 97010

EXPLANATION: Matter in *italics* is new language.

AUTHORITY: NRS 445B.210 and 445B.760

Section 1. NAC 445B is hereby amended by adding a new section:

“Restored Vehicle” defined. “Restored vehicle” means any vehicle with an original engine or any engine that has been maintained or rebuilt such that it meets the emission standards established by NAC 445.596 for the model year of the vehicle.

Section 2. NAC 445B is hereby amended by adding a new section:

Exemption of restored vehicles from emission programs. A restored vehicle, licensed under provision of NRS 482.381, 482.3812, 482.3814, or 482.3816, shall be exempt from NAC 445B.575 through 445B.601 provided that it has been certified by the Department of Motor Vehicles to meet the following conditions:

- 1. Meets the definition of a restored vehicle.*
- 2 The vehicle must pass the exhaust emission standards specified in NAC 445B.596. The exhaust emission shall be measured by a two-speed idle test performed at an authorized station, authorized inspection station or a state emission lab; and*
- 3. The vehicle emits no visible smoke.*
