Section 1. NAC 440.210 is hereby amended to read as follows:

440.210 Each person who is legally responsible for registering the birth of a child shall

submit a fee to the *health* division of the department of human resources for each birth as

follows:

If paid on or before the 30th day after the date of the birth of the child, the fee is [\$26.]

\$28.

If paid more than 30 days after the date of the birth of the child, the fee is [\$30.] \$32.

Sec. 2. NAC 440.110 is hereby amended to read as follows:

440.110 In the case specified by NRS [440.320 and] 440.325 all information needed for the

new certificate except the name of the child, the information related to the father, and the name

of the informant must be obtained from the original certificate. The name of the child and the

name, age and state of birth of the father must be obtained from the document filed by the father.

The name of the father may appear on the line Informant.
