ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH LCB File No. R054-99

Effective September 27, 1999

AUTHORITY: NRS 450B.490.

Section 1. NAC 450B.955 is hereby amended to read as follows: 450B.955 *In a county whose population is less than 400,000:*

- 1. A do-not-resuscitate identification must be in the form of an identification card, document or medallion that has been approved or issued by [a health authority.] the health division.
- 2. The health division shall issue a do-not-resuscitate identification in one of the forms described in subsection 1 to a qualified patient who submits:
- (a) A completed application containing the items described in NRS 450B.520 and NAC 450B.950; and
 - (b) A fee in the *following* amount [of \$5.]:
- (1) For a do-not-resuscitate identification in the form of an identification card or document, \$5.
- (2) For a do-not-resuscitate identification in the form of a medallion, the actual cost to the health division of manufacturing or obtaining the medallion from a manufacturer, including the cost of shipping, handling and engraving the medallion.
