Need and purpose of the proposed amendments:

- 1. Fee increases are necessary to pay the new administrative cost allocation and a new chemist II position for pesticide and fertilizer analyses.
- 2. Fees need to be established by regulation due to a change in the statutes.

PROPOSED ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO NAC 586.010 PERTAINING TO THE ANNUAL PESTICIDE REGISTRATION FEE.

AUTHORITY: NRS 586.270

586.011 Annual registration fee: Amount of fee for each pesticide registered; separate deposit of portion of fee.

- 1. Each registrant shall pay an annual registration fee of \$\frac{40}{60}\) for each pesticide registered.
- 2. The administrator will deposit in a separate account for the disposal of pesticides, \$5 of each annual registration fee collected pursuant to subsection 1, *up to a maximum of \$35,000 annually*.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO NRS 586 PERTAINING TO RESTRICTED-USE PESTICIDES: REGISTRATION OF SELLER.

Authority: NRS 586.406

Chapter 586 of NAC is hereby amended by adding there to the provisions set forth as sections 1 to 3, inclusive, of this regulation.

Section 1. It is unlawful for any person to sell or offer to sell at the retail level or distribute or deliver for transportation for delivery to the consumer or user a pesticide classified for restricted use pursuant to NRS 586.401 or the Federal Environmental Pesticide Control Act [7 U.S.C. §§ 136 et seq.) without first being registered with the administrator.

Sec. 2. Each person applying for registration must provide a statement including:

- 1. The name and address of the person registering; and
- 2. The name and address of any person who, on behalf of the person registering, sells, offers to sell, distributes or delivers for transportation a restricted-use pesticide.
- 3. All registrations expire on December 31 and are renewable annually.

Sec. 3. Each person registering shall pay:

- 1. An annual registration fee of \$25.
- 2. A penalty fee of \$5 if the registration has expired by the failure to re-register on or before February 1, unless his registration is accompanied by a signed statement that no person named on the registration statement has sold or distributed any restricted-use pesticides during the period of the year during which the registration was not in effect.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NAC 588 PERTAINING TO FEES FOR FERTILIZER AND MINERAL REGISTRATION AND SALE AND DISTRIBUTION FEES.

Authority: NRS 588.170 and NRS 588.210

Chapter 588 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 1 and 2 of this regulation.

Section 1. Annual registration fee for each fertilizer or agricultural mineral combined brand and grade.

1. Each registrant shall pay an annual registration fee of \$40 for each fertilizer or agricultural mineral combined brand and grade.

Section 2 Annual fee for the sale or distribution of fertilizer or agricultural mineral.

- 1. There must be paid to the Division for all commercial fertilizers offered for sale, sold or distributed in this state a fee at the rate of 25 cents on every ton sold, but sales to manufacturers or exchanges between them are exempt.
- 2. There must be paid to the Division for all agricultural minerals offered for sale, sold or distributed in this state a fee of 25 cents per ton on every ton if sold in packages, or 5 cents per ton on every ton sold if sold in bulk, but sales to manufacturers or exchanges between them are exempt.
- 3. Annual sales or distribution of fertilizers of less then 20 tons are exempt from paying the fees.
- 4. Annual sales or distribution of agricultural minerals of less then 20 tons if sold in packages and 100 tons if sold in bulk are exempt from paying the fees.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NAC 590 PERTAINING TO THE SALE OR HOLDING WITH INTENT TO SALE ANTIFREEZE WITH OUT PERMIT PROHIBITED; APPLICATION FOR PERMIT; SAMPLE; FEE; ISSUANCE OF CANCELLATION OF PERMIT.

Authority: NRS 590.380

Chapter 590 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 1 to 3, inclusive, of this regulation.

Section 1. Before any antifreeze may be sold, displayed for sale or held with intent to sell within this state, a sample thereof must be inspected annually by the state sealer of weights and measures.

Section 2. Upon application of the manufacturer, packer, seller or distributor and the payment of a fee of \$50 for each brand of antifreeze submitted, the state sealer of weights and measures shall inspect the antifreeze submitted. If the antifreeze is not adulterated or misbranded, if it meets the standards of the state sealer of weights and measures, and if it is not in violation of NRS 590.340 to 590.450, inclusive, the state sealer of weights and measures shall give the applicant a written permit authorizing its sale in this state for the fiscal year in which the inspection fee is paid.

Section 3. If the state sealer of weights and measures at a later date finds that the product to be sold, displayed for sale or held with intent to sell has been materially altered or adulterated, a change has been made in the name, brand or trade-mark under which the antifreeze is sold, or it violates the provisions of NRS 590.340 to 590.450, inclusive, he shall notify the applicant and the permit must be canceled forthwith.
