# PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION 274

Authority: NRS 488.035, 488.045, 488.620, 501.181, 501.243

**EXPLANATION:** Amends NAC 488.465 to include the Sparks Marina Park swim area and dive area to areas in which vessels are prohibited and amends 488.470 to add Sparks Marina Park to the area limited to vessels without motors and vessels with electric motors. Amends 488.470 to use the term vessel to be consistent with the defined term in NRS 488.035 and the rest of the Nevada Boat Act.

NOTE: Matter in *italics* is new; matter within brackets  $\vdash$  is to be omitted

**Section 1.** NAC 488.465 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**488.465** Vessels are prohibited in areas which are designated by signs and buoys as follows:

- 1. Within the Lake Mead national Recreation Area:

- (c) The swimming area of Galilee at the Episcopal Camp and Conference Center;
- (d) The swimming area of the Lakeridge General Improvement District;
- (e) The swimming area of the Glenbrook Homeowner=s Association;
- (f) The swimming area of the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe;
- (g) The swimming area of the Zephyr Cove Marina; and
