PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY

NOTICE OF WORKSHOPS TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS

October 22, 1999

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division) is proposing new regulations pertaining to captive insurance companies, health insurance for small employers and eligible persons, health maintenance organizations, and service contracts. A workshop has been set for 10:00 a.m., on December 1, 1999, at the offices of the Division, 1665 Hot Springs Road, Suite 152, Carson City, Nevada. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics addressed in the proposed regulations.

- 1. Captive Insurance Companies. The proposed regulation establishes requirements for the filing of an annual report, the minimum standards for an annual audit, requirements for deposits, and standards for reinsurance. The regulation also prescribes the application form and the letter of credit.
- 2. Health Insurance for Small Employers and Eligible Persons. The proposed regulations limit the use of medical questionnaires, requires the use of disclosure forms, and prohibits tied insurance sales.
- 3. Health Maintenance Organizations. The proposed regulations allow fee for service arrangements with providers, amends provisions regarding reserves for premium taxes, and payment on statutory bonds.
- 4. Service Contracts. The proposed regulations establish the fees and documents that must be filed, requirements for claims, and the processing of terminated contracts.
- 5. Workers' Compensation. The proposed regulation repeals the requirement for a declination from the State Industrial Insurance System before accessing the residual market, and allows the advisory organization to file special programs under the residual market to meet market needs.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON REGULATIONS

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption of Regulations of the Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division) will hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m., on December 1, 1999, immediately following a public workshop, at the offices of the Division, 1665 Hot Springs Road, Suite 152, Carson City, Nevada. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulations pertaining to health insurance for small employers and eligible persons.

REGULATIONS CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE FOR SMALL EMPLOYERS AND ELIGIBLE PERSONS

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.060:

- 1. The proposed regulations are needed to address problems that have developed while implementing the health insurance reforms enacted by the 1997 Legislature and to respond to amendments to the health insurance laws by the 1999 Legislature.
- 2. The proposed regulation limits the use of medical questionnaires and rating based on an employee or dependent who has waived coverage, requires the use of health insurance disclosure forms, and prohibits any requirement to purchase other insurance as a precondition to purchasing health insurance.
- 3. Estimated economic effect of the regulation:

On the business which it is to regulate:

The proposed regulation should have neither an immediate nor long-term impact of any significance on the industry.

On the public:

The proposed regulations should have no economic impact on the public.

- 4. The Division expects to incur some additional expense to enforce the proposed regulations.
- 5. The Division is not aware of any overlap or duplication of the regulation with any state, local or federal regulation.
- 6. The proposed regulation does not establish any new fees or increase an existing fee.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Division may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Division, 1665 Hot Springs Road, Suite 152, Carson City, Nevada 89706. Written submissions must be received by the Division on or before November 29, 1999. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Division may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY

REGULATIONS CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE FOR SMALL EMPLOYERS AND ELIGIBLE PERSONS

Authority: NRS 679B.130, NRS 689A.740, NRS 689C.600

- Section 1. Chapter 689C of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 4, inclusive, of this regulation.
- Sec. 2. A small employer carrier shall not request a medical questionnaire or calculate a premium rate for a small employer group based on underwriting information for an employee or dependent that has waived coverage.
- Sec. 3. A small employer carrier shall provide it's sales representatives with product information including a health disclosure form summarizing the small employer group and conversion basic and standard health benefit plans that have been approved by the commissioner.
- Sec. 4. A small employer carrier shall not require the purchase of a group life insurance policy or any other form of insurance as a requirement for the purchase or renewal of a small employer group health benefit plan.

- Sec. 5. Chapter 689A of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 6 and 7 of this regulation.
- Sec. 6. An individual carrier shall provide it's sales representatives with product information including a health disclosure form summarizing the individual basic and standard health benefit plans that have been approved by the commissioner.
- Sec. 7. An individual carrier shall not require the purchase of a life insurance policy or any other form of insurance as a requirement for the purchase or renewal of a individual basic and standard health benefit plan.
