PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PUBLIC SAFETY

NAC 483.475 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. The department will administer [a] *applicable* driving skills tests to an applicant for reinstatement of his driver's license in, but not limited to, the following instances:
- (a) He has been convicted of six or more moving violations, *or four or more moving violations while operating a commercial motor vehicle* during the 4-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
- (b) He has been involved in more than one accident in which he was at fault during the 1-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
 - (c) He is applying for an upgrade in the type or classification of his license;
- (d) He is applying for an additional endorsement not on the license which was withdrawn that requires a driving skills test;
 - (e) The license has expired or has been withdrawn for 1 year or more; or
- (f) The license was withdrawn because of the failure of the applicant to complete a driving skills test.
- 2. The department will administer [a] *applicable* knowledge tests, or a test more specific to a particular classification or endorsement, to an applicant for reinstatement of his driver's license in, but not limited to, the following instances:
- (a) He has been convicted of three or more moving violations, *or two or more moving violations while operating a commercial motor vehicle* during the 4-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
 - (b) He is applying for an upgrade in the type or classification of his license;
- (c) He is applying for an additional endorsement on his license which was withdrawn that requires a knowledge test;
 - (d) The license has expired or has been withdrawn for 1 year or more; or
- (e) The license was withdrawn because of the failure of the applicant to complete a knowledge test.

NAC 483.478 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 6. Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (h) of subsection 1 of NRS 62.211 and subsection 2 of NRS 62.2263, if the department has revoked or suspended a driver's license pursuant to chapter 62, 483, 484 or 485 of NRS, before the reinstatement of the license, the applicant must, in addition to complying with any other conditions required by law:
- [1.] (a) Comply with the requirements for the reinstatement of a driver's license set forth in NAC 483.471 and 483.475;

- [2.] (b) Provide any additional information requested by the department for the evaluation of the applicant's fitness to operate a motor vehicle safely and any other information that the department deems relevant; and
 - [3.] (c) Pay the required fees.
- 7. When the privilege to operate both commercial and non-commercial motor vehicles is withdrawn, the applicant must:
- (a) Meet applicable reinstatement requirements for non-commercial driving privileges before reinstating commercial driving privileges;
- (b) Except as provided in NAC 483.471, comply with all written, vision and drive testing requirement fees for the reinstatement of each driving privilege;
 - (c) Pay the reinstatement fees for each driving privilege; and
 - (d) Pay applicable application fees for each type of license or permit being issued.
- 8. When both commercial and non-commercial driving privileges are withdrawn and an applicant only reinstates his privilege to drive a non-commercial vehicle, the status of the commercial driving privilege shall remain withdrawn until applicable reinstatement requirements are met.
