NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN EDUCATION

The Nevada Commission on Professional Standards in Education will hold a public hearing on <u>March 24, 2001</u>, at Valley High School, Room 104, 2839 South Burnham, <u>Las Vegas</u>, Nevada.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendments/adoptions of regulations of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Commission on Professional Standards in Education may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

Public Hearing and Possible Adoption of changes to Licensure Requirements of Persons with Revocations of License in other jurisdictions.

NOTE: This is a ONE time Public Hearing. Action may be taken.

The need for and the purpose of the proposed amendments is to have teachers remove revocations or suspensions prior to requesting a renewal license from the State Department of Education.

There is no economic effect of the regulation on the business that it regulates. There are no adverse effects. The beneficial effect would eliminate the chance that the State Department could renew a license that had been suspended or revoked.

There is no immediate or long term effect.

There is no economic effect of the regulation on the public. There are no adverse, immediate or long-term effects. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation is none.

There are no federal laws affecting the proposed regulations and there is no duplication or overlap of state or local governmental agencies. The proposed regulation does not establish a new fee or does not increase an existing fee.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Commission on Professional Standards in Education may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Commission Secretary, Nevada Department of Education, 700 East Fifth Street, Carson City, Nevada 89701-5096. The Department of Education must receive written submissions on or before March 12, 2001.

The text of each regulation includes the entire text of any section of the Nevada Administrative Code that is proposed for amendment or repeal. Copies will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies, if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either prior to adoption or within 30 day thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.

PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN EDUCATION

Explanation: Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: 1 and 2, NRS 391.019 ad 291.032

Section 1 NAC 391 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2

- 1. The Superintendent of Public instruction or his designee shall not issue a license to any applicant who has a revoked, suspended license or other disciplinary action against their license by another jurisdiction until such time as the revoking, suspending or disciplinary jurisdiction reinstates the license with no provisions, restrictions, or conditions; and
- 2. In the event that a revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary action by another jurisdiction has been discovered after the issuance of a license, the Superintendent of Public Instruction or his designee shall immediately invalidate the license; and
- 3. The invalidated license shall remain so until the revoking, suspending or disciplinary jurisdiction reinstates the license with no provisions, restrictions or conditions.
- 4. In the event that the cause of the revocation, suspension or other disciplinary action in another jurisdiction prohibits the issuance of a license according to the statutes and regulations in this state, the Superintendent of Public Instruction or his designee shall not issue a license; and
- 5. In the event that a revocation, suspension, or other disciplinary action by another jurisdiction has been discovered after the issuance of a license, and the cause of the revocation, suspension or other disciplinary action in another jurisdiction prohibits the issuance of a license according to the statutes and regulations in this state the Superintendent of Public Instruction or his designee shall immediately invalidate the license and not reinstate this license.
