2. For each classification of a license for which a certificate of eligibility is requested, the applicant must be a [general] contractor who is licensed in the classification for which the certificate is being sought pursuant to the provisions of chapter 624 of NRS on the date that he submits the application and who has been licensed as a [general] contractor in the classification for which the certificate is being sought for the 5 years immediately preceding the date on which he submits the application.

NAC 624.6853 "Affidavit for a certificate of eligibility" defined. "Affidavit for a certificate of eligibility" means an affidavit from a certified public accountant required pursuant to [subsection 3] of NRS 338.1389 or subsection 3 of NRS 338.147.

NAC 624.6855 "Affidavit for renewal of a certificate of eligibility" defined. "Affidavit for renewal of a certificate of eligibility" means an affidavit from a certified public accountant required pursuant to [subsection 5] of NRS 338.1389 or [subsection 5] of NRS 338.147.

NAC 624.6859 ["General] contractor" defined. ["General] contractor" means:

- 1. A general engineering contractor;
- 2. A general building contractor;
- 3. A general engineering and general building contractor; or
- 4. A specialty contractor who is able to act as a prime contractor, who is properly licensed pursuant to the provisions of chapter 624 of NRS.

NAC 624.6863 "Statement of compliance" defined. "Statement of compliance" means a statement from a [general] contractor who applies for a certificate of eligibility which states that the [general] contractor is properly licensed pursuant to the provisions of chapter 624 of NRS for the certificate of eligibility for which he is applying.

NAC 624.687 Required documents; qualifications; separate application for each classification.

- 1. A [general] contractor who wishes to obtain a certificate of eligibility must submit to the board:
 - (a) An application on a form provided by the board;
 - (b) A notarized affidavit for a certificate of eligibility on a form provided by the board;
 - (c) A notarized statement of compliance on a form provided by the board;
 - (d) The fee set forth in NAC 624.130; and
 - (e) Any other documentation required by the board.
- 2. For each classification of a license for which a certificate of eligibility is requested, the applicant must be a [general] contractor who is licensed pursuant to the provisions of chapter 624 of NRS on the date that he submits the application and who has been licensed as a general contractor for the 5 years immediately preceding the date on which he submits the application.
- 3. If an applicant has more than one classification of a license as a [general] contractor, he must submit a separate application for each classification of a license for which a certificate of eligibility is requested and must satisfy all applicable requirements pursuant to NRS 338.1389 or 338.147.

NAC 624.6883 Issuance of duplicate certificate. The board will issue a duplicate certificate of eligibility to any **[general]** contractor who has received a certificate of eligibility and who certifies that his certificate of eligibility has been lost or destroyed.

NAC 624.6889 Issuance of certificate prohibited if license not active; revocation; reapplication. The board will not issue a certificate of eligibility to a [general] contractor whose license is not on active status. If the [general] contractor whose license is not on active status has received a certificate of eligibility, the board will revoke the certificate of eligibility. Such a contractor must reapply for a certificate of eligibility pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 338.1389 or subsection 3 of NRS 338.147 and NAC 624.685 to 624.6899, inclusive.

NAC 624.6893 Disciplinary action.

- 1. If a [general] contractor who applies to the board for a certificate of eligibility submits false or misleading information, submits an application which is incomplete or does not comply with this chapter or chapter 338 or 624 of NRS, the board may:
 - (a) Deny the application;

- (b) If the contractor has received a certificate of eligibility, revoke the certificate of eligibility; or
 - (c) Take such actions that the board deems appropriate under the circumstances.
- 2. In carrying out the provisions of this section, the board may rely on information contained in the records maintained by the board and need not conduct any investigation, inquiry or hearing regarding the information contained in those records.

NAC 624.6896 Written objection filed with public body. If a written objection is filed with a public body pursuant to subsection 11 of NRS 338.1389 or subsection 11 of NRS 338.147, the board will, upon request by the public body, provide to the public body a copy of the application of the [general] contractor against whom the complaint was made and any documentation submitted with the application.
