NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION

Notice of Hearing for The (Amendment) of Regulations of The Board Of Wildlife Commissioners

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 8:30 a.m. on February 8, 2003, at the Las Vegas City Council Chambers, 400 Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulation CGR 311 (Temporary) (LCB File T002-03), pertaining to Chapter 502 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

- 1. The need for and purpose of the proposed regulation: (Description of regulation) Reduce the time requirement for return of tag questionnaires in order to facilitate more timely receipt of harvest data and delivery of same to Nevada Division of Wildlife biologists, County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife.
- 2. Text of the proposed regulation: see attachment.

PROPOSED TEMPORARY REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION 311 (TEMPORARY) (LCB File No. T002-03)

Authority: NRS 501.105, 501.119, 501.181 & 502.160

Notice of Intent: January 3, 2003 **Workshop Date:** February 7, 2003

EXPLANATION: Reduce the time requirement for return of tag questionnaires in order to facilitate more timely receipt of harvest data and delivery of same to Nevada Division of Wildlife biologists, County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife.

NOTE: Matter in *italics* is new; matter within brackets [is to be omitted.

Section 1. NAC 502.405 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 502.405. 1. Unless otherwise provided by an annual regulation of the commission, the questionnaire issued as part of a tag must be properly completed and received by [the headquarters of] the division *or its agent* not later than 5 p.m. on the [last weekday of January] *fifteenth day* following the close of the season to which the tag applies.
- 2. Any person who fails to return the questionnaire within the period specified or who submits incomplete or false information on the questionnaire will be denied all big game tags for 1 year.
- 3. Any person who has been denied all big game tags pursuant to the provisions of this section may have those privileges reinstated if he pays to the division an administrative fine of \$50.
