AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 391.019.

A REGULATION relating to educational personnel; revising the requirements for an endorsement to teach drivers' education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 391.225 is hereby amended to read as follows:

391.225 [1.] To receive an endorsement authorizing the teaching of a course in drivers' education, a person must:

- [(a)] 1. Hold a bachelor's degree;
- [(b)] 2. Hold a secondary license; and
- [(c)] 3. Have completed fan approved basic course in drivers' education.
- 2. To renew such an endorsement for the first time, the holder must show that he has earned 2 semester hours of credit in an advanced course in drivers' education during the term of the endorsement. After the first renewal, the endorsement will be automatically renewed upon the holder's renewal of his secondary license.] 3 semester hours of credit in basic concepts of drivers' education and traffic safety from an accredited college or university.
