A REGULATION relating to common-interest communities; establishing a fee for the examination required to obtain a certificate for the management of a common-interest community; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

- **Section 1.** NAC 116.130 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 116.130 1. Each applicant for a certificate must [take] pass an examination which has been approved by the Division [.] with a minimum score of 75 percent.
 - 2. The fee for the examination required pursuant to subsection 1 is \$100.
- 3. The Division shall notify an applicant of the time and place of each examination *required* pursuant to subsection 1 not later than 30 days before the date scheduled for the examination.
- [2. To pass the examination, an applicant must receive a score of at least 75 percent on the examination.
- 3.] 4. An applicant who fails the examination *required pursuant to subsection 1* may retake the examination.
