AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 445B.785.

A REGULATION relating to motor vehicles; revising provisions governing exhaust gas analyzers that are used to perform inspections of certain motor vehicles at test stations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** NAC 445B.5052 is hereby amended to read as follows:

445B.5052 1. A test station shall use an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer to perform an inspection of a motor vehicle *that is* subject to the provisions of NAC 445B.580 [...] *or* 445B.5805.

- 2. The Department will not enroll an exhaust gas analyzer for a test station licensed by the Department on or after July 1, 2006, unless it is an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer [.] equipped with hardware and software components that are capable of inspecting a motor vehicle containing a certified on-board diagnostic system which uses controller area network communication.
- 3. On and after September 30, 2006, a test station shall use an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer that satisfies the requirements of subsection 2. On and after September 30, 2006, a representative of the Department will deactivate each NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer that is used by a test station if the gas analyzer does not satisfy the requirements of subsection 2. The
