AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 624.100 and 624.112.

A REGULATION relating to the State Contractors' Board; revising the qualifications for compliance investigators employed by the Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** NAC 624.135 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 624.135 Each person who is employed by the Board as a compliance investigator must have:
- 1. A valid certificate in construction skills issued by [the International Conference of Building Officials or] a nationally recognized organization [that adopts building codes which have been adopted by the State of Nevada or a local government in this State; and
  - 2. One of the following:

-(a);

- 2. A high school diploma and at least 4 years of progressively responsible experience performing field investigations;
- 3. A high school diploma and [have] at least 4 years of experience in the construction industry as a contractor, journeyman, foreman or supervising employee, or the equivalent thereof, as determined by the Board;

- [(b)] 4. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in preengineering, construction inspection or construction technology, or a related area of study as determined by the Board, and [have] at least 3 years of experience in the construction industry as a contractor, journeyman, foreman or supervising employee, or the equivalent thereof, as determined by the Board; or
- [(c)] 5. Any sufficient combination of education and experience as determined by the Board.
