PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

AUTHORITY: §§1 and 2, NRS 630.130, 630.275, 630.279 and 630.336.

A REGULATION relating to medical practitioners; providing that the Board of Medical Examiners keep confidential certain records concerning a practitioner of respiratory care; providing that the Board keep confidential certain records concerning a perfusionist; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 630.275 is hereby amended to read as follows:

NEW FIRST PARALLEL SECTION

630.275 The Board will, pursuant to [paragraph (e) of] subsection 3 of NRS 630.336, keep confidential all records relating to a program established by the Board to enable a physician, [or] physician assistant *or practitioner of respiratory care* to correct:

- 1. A dependence upon alcohol or a controlled substance; or
- 2. Any other impairment which could result in the revocation of his license.
- Sec. 2. Section 1 of LCB File No. R044-09 is hereby amended to read as follows:

NEW SECOND PARALLEL SECTION 630.275 The Board will, pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 630.336, keep confidential all records relating to a program established by the Board to enable a physician, physician assistant, [or] practitioner of respiratory care *or perfusionist* to correct:

- 1. A dependence upon alcohol or a controlled substance; or
- 2. Any other impairment which could result in the revocation of his license.

- **Sec. 3.** 1. This section and section 1 of this regulation become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
 - 2. Section 1 of this regulation expires by limitation on June 30, 2010.
 - 3. Section 2 of this regulation becomes effective on July 1, 2010.
