PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; mater in bracket formitted material is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: NRS 482.281

A REGULATION relating to motor vehicles; providing certain requirements for determining a person's suitability to renew vehicle registrations at participating emission test stations; and other matters thereto.

Section 1. NAC 482.720 is hereby amended to read as follows:

NAC 482.720 Eligibility to participate. (NRS 482.281) To be eligible to participate in the program, an authorized inspection station or authorized station must not:

- 1. Have committed any violation set forth in NRS 445B.790;
- 2. Employ or be owned, in whole or in part, by any person who has *ever* been convicted of a felony for committing a crime involving moral turpitude, including, without limitation:
 - (a) A deceptive trade practice;
 - (b) Embezzlement; [or]
 - (c) Fraud; or
 - (d) Financial crimes;
- 3. Have issued a check to the Department in payment of the fee to obtain forms certifying emission control compliance set forth in NRS 445B.830 that was returned for insufficient money or credit to pay the check; or
- 4. Have been convicted of a felony within the past seven years if the conviction is for a crime other than described in subsection 2.
 - [4.] 5. Possess a license from the Department to engage in the activities of:

- (a) A vehicle transporter pursuant to the provisions of NRS 482.3161;
- (b) A broker of vehicles pursuant to the provisions of NRS 482.333;
- (c) Dismantling, scrapping, processing or wrecking a vehicle pursuant to the provisions of NRS 487.050;
 - (d) Operating a salvage pool pursuant to the provisions of NRS 487.410; or
 - (e) Operating a body shop pursuant to the provisions of NRS 487.610.
