INTERMEDIARY SERVICE ORGANIZATION TO PROVIDE PERSONAL CARE SERVICES IN THE HOME

General Provisions

Section 1. Chapter 427A of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as section 1, inclusive, of these regulations.

Sec. 2. Definitions:

- 1. "Division" means the Aging and Disability Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services.
- [2. "Office" means the Office of Disability Services of the Department of Health and Human Services.]

Sec. 3. Fees

The ISO must pay to the [Office] Division a nonrefundable fee [of \$2,748] to apply for a certificate, and annually to renew a certificate. [An applicant for the renewal of a certificate must pay to the Office a nonrefundable fee of \$1,374.] The fee may be periodically adjusted by the Division, based upon only those costs directly and indirectly allocable to the implementation and enforcement of the statutes and regulations which are applicable to the certification of Intermediary Service Organizations. Each certificate issued expires on December 31 following its issuance and is renewable for 1 year upon reapplication and payment of all fees required.
