## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION Notice of Hearing for the Revised Regulation Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 458

The Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services (MHDS), Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Agency (SAPTA) are revising Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), Chapter 458 - Abuse of Alcohol and Drugs. A public hearing will be part of the Mental Health Commission meeting on Friday, September 16, 2011, 9:00 a.m. being held in Sparks at the Sierra Regional Center, 605 South 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Room 122, Sparks, Nevada.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested parties regarding the Amendment of regulations that pertain to NAC Chapter 458, (Attached).

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

The amendment will make the necessary changes that occurred when the Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse was moved from the Nevada State Health Division to the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services. Additionally, it involves changing the Bureau to an Agency and renaming to the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Agency.

2. If the proposed regulation is a temporary regulation, either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended, or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved. If the proposed regulation is a permanent regulation, a statement explaining how to obtain the approved or revised text of the proposed regulation prepared by the Legislative Counsel pursuant to NRS 233B.063.

The proposed amendment to NAC 458 is permanent. - 3. A statement identifying the methods used by the agency in determining the impact on a small business prepared pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 233B.0608.

SAPTA has determined through review of the language of the proposed regulation, the opportunity for comment at the workshop, and written submissions that the proposed changes to NAC 458 would not impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business or restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business.

- 4. The estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately and in each case must include:
  - (a) Both adverse and beneficial effects; and

The proposed amendments should have no economic impact on affected businesses or on the public.

(b) Both immediate and long-term effects.

The proposed amendments should have no immediate or long-term economic effects on businesses or the public.

5. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation.

There will be no additional cost to the Agency to enforce the amendments when adopted.

6. A description of and citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.

There are no other state or government agency regulations that the proposed amendments duplicate.
