A REGULATION relating to the licensing of producers of continuous care coverage as defined pursuant to Senate Bill 195 of the 2009 Legislative Session.

Section 1. Chapter 683A of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2, 3 and 4 of this regulation.

Sec. 2. To market continuous care coverage as defined pursuant to Senate Bill 195 of the 2009 Legislative Session, a person must

- (a) be licensed to act as a producer of accident and health insurance and as a producer of casualty insurance; or
- (b) be licensed to act as a producer of accident and health insurance and have received approval from the Commissioner to market continuous care coverage.

Sec. 3. The Commissioner will approve producers of accident and health insurance to market continuous care coverage if, in the 6 months preceding the request to market continuous care coverage, the producer has successfully completed at least 8 hours of instruction approved by the Commissioner for continuous care coverage.

Sec. 4. The education required pursuant to section 3 of this regulation may be counted toward the continuing education hours required pursuant to NAC 683A.330.
