PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

A REGULATION relating to wildlife; establishes provisions pertaining to blinds used for the hunting of wildlife.

Section 1. Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto section 2 through 7, inclusive of this regulation, to read as follows.

Section 2. No person shall erect or make use of a blind for the purpose of hunting within 200 feet of a wildlife water development or wildlife guzzler.

- Section 3. No person shall erect a blind or make use of a blind for the purpose of hunting made from any natural foliage, shrubbery, bush or other vegetation.
 - (a) The provisions of this section do not apply to blinds erected or used on private property.
- Section 4. No person shall make use of a blind for the purpose of hunting that was erected at a time prior to 96 hours before a big game hunting season, in a management area where that person holds a tag to hunt antelope, deer, elk, mountain goat or bighorn sheep.
 - (a) The provisions of this section do not apply to blinds erected or used on private property.

Section 5. Any blind erected and used to hunt antelope, deer, elk, mountain goat or bighorn sheep must be removed:

- (a) Within 24 hours of killing wildlife specified on a persons tag.
- (b) If a person is unsuccessful, at the conclusion of the hunting season for which that person holds a tag.
- (c) The provisions of this section do not apply to blinds erected or used on private property.

Section 6. For purposes of this section "wildlife water development or wildlife guzzler" means an artificial or enhanced natural catch basin designed to collect water for use by wildlife.

Section 7. For purposes of this section "blind" means any structure or shelter erected by a person with peripheral cover designed to conceal a hunter.
