AUTHORITY: § 1, NRS 284.065, 284.155, 284.4065 and 284.407.

A REGULATION relating to state personnel; revising the standards and procedures used to conduct screening tests that detect controlled substances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 284.882 is hereby amended to read as follows:

284.882 A screening test to detect the general presence of:

- 1. A controlled substance must comply with [the]
- (a) The standards [and procedures] established by the United States Department of Health and Human Services which are hereby adopted by reference. A copy of the standards [and procedures] is available, without charge, from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Center for Substance Abuse Prevention, Division of Workplace Programs, 1 Choke Cherry Road, Rockville, Maryland 20857 [.]; and
 - (b) Any supplementary standards and procedures established by the Commission.
- 2. Alcohol by testing a person's breath must be conducted using a breath-testing device certified in accordance with the "Conforming Products List of Evidential Breath Alcohol Measurement Devices" published in the Federal Register by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the United States Department of Transportation.
