A REGULATION relating to educational personnel; revising provisions governing the requirements for a comprehensive major or minor in social studies; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 391.1306 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 391.1306 1. [The semester hours of credit required for a] A comprehensive major in social studies [must include at least 3] consists of 36 semester hours of credit as follows:
- (a) Twenty-one semester hours of credit which must include at least 3 semester hours in each of the following areas [, 24 of which must have been in the areas named in paragraphs (e), (f) and (g):

- (a)] of study:

(1) Economics;

(2) Geography;

[(c) Psychology or sociology;

(d) Ethnic studies;

(e) Political science;

— (f) (3) History of the United States; [and

 $-\frac{(g)}{(4)}$ History of the world $\frac{(1)}{(1)}$;

- (5) Political science;
- (6) Ethnic studies; and
- (7) Psychology or sociology; and
- (b) Fifteen semester hours of credit in any of the areas of study listed in subparagraphs (1) to (5), inclusive, of paragraph (a).
- 2. [The semester hours of credit required for a] A comprehensive minor in social studies [must include at least 3] consists of 24 semester hours [each in any four] of credit as follows:
- (a) Fifteen semester hours of credit which must include at least 3 semester hours in each of the following areas [listed in subsection 1, at least 16] of study:
 - (1) Economics;
 - (2) Geography;
 - (3) History of the United States;
 - (4) History of the world; and
 - (5) Political science;
- (b) Six semester hours of [which must be] credit in any of the areas of study listed in [paragraphs (e), (f) and (g) of subsection 1.] subparagraphs (1) to (5), inclusive, of paragraph (a); and
 - (c) Three semester hours of credit in any of the following areas of study:
 - (1) Ethnic studies; or
 - (2) Psychology or sociology.
