PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN EDUCATION

[NAC 391.173 Qualifications for issuance of unconditional endorsement as professional administrator of school to person who holds conditional endorsement. (NRS 391.019, 391.032)

- 1. To qualify for an endorsement as a professional administrator of a school, the holder of the conditional endorsement issued pursuant to NAC 391.171 must, within 3 years for which the conditional endorsement is valid:
 - (a) Complete at least 18 semester hours of graduate courses in the administration of a school, including:
 - (1) Administration and organization of a school;
 - (2) Supervision and evaluation of instruction;
 - (3) Development of personnel;
 - (4) Finances of a school;
 - (5) The laws that apply to schools; and
 - (6) Curriculum; and
 - (b) Complete:
 - (1) An additional 18 semester hours of graduate courses which may include other courses considered to be part of an administrative program for educators; or
 - (2) An additional 12 semester hours of graduate courses which may include other courses considered to be part of an administrative consortium which has been approved by the Department.
- 2. If a person who holds a conditional endorsement as a professional administrator of a school completes the requirements of this section and NAC 391.172 within the 3 years for which the conditional endorsement is valid, the Department shall issue an endorsement as a professional administrator of a school that is unconditional on the person's valid license to teach.]
