A REGULATION relating to licensure; revising provisions concerning the expiration of a license; providing an exception to allow for the refund of the fees for biennial registration under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 630.175 is hereby amended to read as follows:

630.175 Unless the license has [been suspended] expired for nonpayment of the fee for registration, any person licensed to practice by the Board after July 1 of the second year of a period of biennial registration shall pay one-half of the fee for biennial registration for the current period of biennial registration. Any person licensed to practice by the Board after commencement of a period of biennial registration, but on or before July 1 of the second year of a period of biennial registration, shall pay the full fee for biennial registration. [The] Except as otherwise provided by specific regulation, the fees for biennial registration are not refundable.
