AUTHORITY: NRS 634.030 and 634.014.

A REGULATION relating to the definition of the term "precisely controlled force" as that term is used in NRS 634.014.

**Section 1.** NAC chapter 634 is hereby amended to add the following new language:

As used in 634.014, a "precisely controlled force" shall mean:

- 1. A thrust involving both amplitude and velocity, including but not limited to, thrusts of any combination of high or low amplitude and high or low velocities; or
- 2. An application of a resistive movement by applying a specific force, without the use of a thrust, which is directed into a focal point of the anatomy.
