A Note About the Statistics in This Document

With the exception of voter registration data on page 29, the statistical information displayed in this document was extracted from the United States Bureau of the Census's 2019–2023 5-Year American Community Survey (ACS), which became available on December 12, 2024. The ACS provides estimates of demographic, economic, housing, and social characteristics for numerous geographies every year, including five-year period estimates that describe the characteristics of an area over a specific period of time rather than for a specific point in time. Therefore, these data may not be comparable with point-in-time estimates. In this document, we have used estimates that the Bureau of the Census compiled at the legislative district and State levels for Nevada, as well as corresponding national data. Figures for active voters were obtained from the website of Nevada's Secretary of State on January 13, 2025. The Secretary of State updates these figures on a regular basis. For the most current voter registration information, visit www.nvsos.gov/sos/elections/voters/voter-registration-statistics.




Chart 1—Population Distribution by Age









Chart 5—Population by Race





Chart 6—Population by Hispanic or Latino Origin



Chart 8—Labor Force Participation Rate*





Chart 9—Labor Force Participation Rate* by Gender









Chart 12—Percentage of Households at Various Income Levels







Chart 14—Percentage of Households Receiving Food Stamps/SNAP





Chart 15—Percentage of the Population With Incomes Below 100% of the Poverty Level



Chart 16—Poverty Level by Age Group














Chart 21—Percentage of Car, Truck, or Van Commuters Who Drove Alone Versus Carpooled



Chart 24—Percent Uninsured










Chart 29—Home Occupancy





Chart 30—Tenancy of Occupied Housing Units






Chart 32—Registered Voters by Party (December 2024)
