A Brief Note About the Statistics in This Document

With the exception of voter registration data on page 28, the statistical information displayed in this document was extracted from the U.S. Bureau of the Census, 2011-2015 5-Year American Community Survey (ACS), which became available on December 8, 2016. The ACS provides estimates of demographic, housing, social, and economic characteristics for numerous geographies every year including 5-year estimates for all geographies down to the block group level. In this document, we have used estimates that the Bureau of the Census has compiled at the legislative district and state levels for Nevada, as well as corresponding national data.

The ACS produces period estimates that describe the average socioeconomic and housing characteristics of an area over a specific period of time, not for a specific point in time. Therefore, these data may not be comparable with point-in-time estimates. Additional information about the ACS is available at the following website: https://factfinder.census.gov/.

Figures for active voters were obtained from Nevada's Office of the Secretary of State's website. Those figures are updated by the Secretary of State on a regular basis. The data included herein were the most currently available statistics at the time this document was prepared. 


Chart 1--Population Distribution by Age




Chart 2--Median Age (in years)*





*Old-Age Dependency Ratio is the number of elderly people (65+) in a population divided by the total adult working age population (18-64) times 100.



Chart 5--Population by Race





Chart 6--Population by Hispanic or Latino Origin





Chart 7--Labor Force Participation Rate*















Chart 13--Percentage of the Population With Incomes Below 100% of the Poverty Level





Chart 14--Poverty Level by Age Groups







Chart 16--Poverty Level by Hispanic or Latino Origin






Chart 17--Percentage of Workers Who Work at Home

Chart 18--Methods of Travel to Work







Chart 19--Travel Time to Work










Chart 20--Educational Attainment



Chart 21--Percent Uninsured




Chart 23--Percentage of Employed Who Are Uninsured





Chart 24--Percentage of Unemployed Who Are Uninsured



Chart 27--Occupied Housing Units




Chart 28--Owner Occupied Housing Units





Chart 29--Renter Occupied Housing Units






