I. PREFACE

This booklet contains statistical tables for the redistricting plans adopted by the 2001 Nevada Legislature in the 17th Special Session (SS) and the minor modifications adopted by the 2003 Nevada Legislature in the 72nd Regular Session (RS). This data reflects the plans adopted under the following acts:

- S.B. 14 (of the 17th SS) - Chapter 23, Statutes of Nevada, 2001 Special Session (for House of Representative Districts - Congressional)
- S.B. 14 (of the 17th SS) and AB 375 (of the 72nd RS) - Chapter 135, Statutes of Nevada, 2003 (for State Legislative Districts - Senate and Assembly)
- S.B. 14 (of the 17th SS) and AB 375 (of the 72nd RS) (for University Board of Regents)
- S.B. 14 (of the 17th SS) and AB 375 (of the 72nd RS) (for State Board of Education Districts)

The reports in this publication are produced by the Nevada Legislature's Geographic Information System.

The population reports and data are derived from the 2000 Census Public Law 94-171 Redistricting Data provided by the United States Bureau of the Census.

The voter registration and election reports are based on data provided by Nevada's county clerks and registrars of voters which was placed into the system by staff of the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB). The voter registration data reflects figures as of the close of registration before the General Elections in 2000, 1998 and 1996, which were aggregated to the newly formed 2001 districts.

The elections database contains the results of selected statewide races in those election years which also were aggregated to the newly formed 2001 districts. The statewide races in the database are as follows:

- 2000 U.S. Presidential Race (Bush vs. Gore)
- 2000 U. S. Senate Race (Bernstein vs. Ensign)
- 1998 U.S. Senate Race (Ensign vs. Reid)
- 1996 U.S. Presidential Race (Clinton vs. Dole)
