Below our Boundary Lines are described in detail. Each Congressional District (CD) boundary line will begin at the northwest corner of our proposed CD and continue east in a clockwise direction; our boundary line will make a loop and finish at its starting point. Our Latitude and Longitude lines vary slightly from the nearby Census Block lines, but they make for straighter lines and a much cleaner looking map – and they don't alter the population totals. Also, for a professional mapmaker there is nothing easier than drawing a map based on Latitude and Longitude lines. Latitude and Longitude lines were used to create the northeast boundary lines for CD-1 in during the last redistricting in 2001. Each CD has a target number of 675,138.

- CD-1. Begin along the boundary line of Nye County and Clark County, at Latitude line 36.1303 and go due east until you intersect with State Route 159. This location is also the northeast starting point of the Red Rock Scenic Loop Drive. Follow Hwy 159 northeast to Constable Street. Constable shows up on the Nevada State redistricting terminal at the Sawyer Building, but it is not listed on "Google Maps." Constable is west of Hwy 215 and it is probably a right-of-way, *it is also a census block line*. Go north on Constable to what is listed as both Ream Way and Far Hills Avenue. Go east on Far Hills until it becomes Hualapai Way, then southeast on Hualapai to Town Center Drive. Go northeast on Town Center to Summerlin Parkway and east on Summerlin to Hwy 95, east on Hwy 95 to Eastern Avenue, south on Eastern to Warm Springs and west on Warm Springs to Hwy 215. Go south on Hwy 215 to Eastern Avenue and south on Eastern to St. Rose Parkway, then southwest on St. Rose to Hwy 15. Go southwest on Hwy 15 to the Californian state line, then northwest on the state line to the Pahrump County line, and north on this county line to your starting point. Total population 675,166 +28 from the target number. Compaction score .57.
- CD-2. Begin at the point where the Nevada/California/Oregon state lines meet. Go east along the northern boundary line of Nevada to the Utah state line, then turn south and follow this Utah boundary line to the northeast corner of Lincoln County. Go west and stay on the northern boundary lines of Lincoln, Nye and Mineral Counties, then follow the Union Pacific Railroad tracks northwest to Wabuska Road and go southwest on Wabuska. When you get to Campbell Lane go west on Campbell to the Douglas County line and then follow this line south to Latitude line 38.8383, then go west on this line to Hwy 395, this point is the intersection of Ohoctah Ridge Road and Hwy 395. Go northwest on Hwy 395 to Riverview Drive, southwest on Riverview, south on Fairway Drive, west on South Riverview Drive, south on Dresslerville Road, southwest on Muir Drive, south on Lyell Way, west on James Road, west on Kimmerling Road, north on State Route 88, and then west on Centerville Lane to the end of the road. The end of Centerville Lane is on Latitude line 38.9104, continue on this Latitude line for another two miles to the California state line, then follow the state line north to your stating point. Total population 675,228 +90 from the target number. Compaction score .63.
- CD-3. Begin on Hwy 15 and Lake Mead South Blvd. Go east to Las Vegas Blvd/State Route 604, go northeast on Las Vegas Blvd to Speedway Blvd. Speedway is on Latitude line 36.2715, follow this line due east until you reach Longitude line -114.690 and follow this line south to where it touches the Arizona state line in the middle of Lake Mead. Follow the Arizona state line south until the Arizona, Nevada and California state lines intersect. Follow the Nevada state line northwest to Hwy 15, go northeast on Hwy 15 to St. Rose Parkway and follow St. Rose to Eastern Avenue. Go north on Eastern to Hwy 215 and follow Hwy 215 northwest to Warm

Springs Road, go east on Warm Springs back to Eastern Avenue, and then go north on Eastern. Stay on Eastern until you reach Hwy 95, go northwest on Hwy 95 to Hwy 15 and then northeast on Hwy 15 to your starting point. Total population 675,112 -26 from the target number. Compaction score .47.

CD-4. Begin at the California state line and Douglas County at Latitude 38.9104 and go due east on this Latitude line for two miles until you intersect with the western end of Centerville Lane. Then follow the CD-2 boundary line east to the Utah state line. Go south on the Utah state line, then the Arizona state line until you reach the Colorado River. Follow this Arizona boundary line southwest to Longitude line -114.690, this is also the boundary line for CD-3. Follow this CD-3 boundary line north and then west until it touches the CD-1 boundary line at Hwy 95, then follow the CD-1 boundary line west and then south to the California State line. Go northwest on along the California state line to your starting point. Total population 675,045 -93 from the target number. Compaction score .52.
