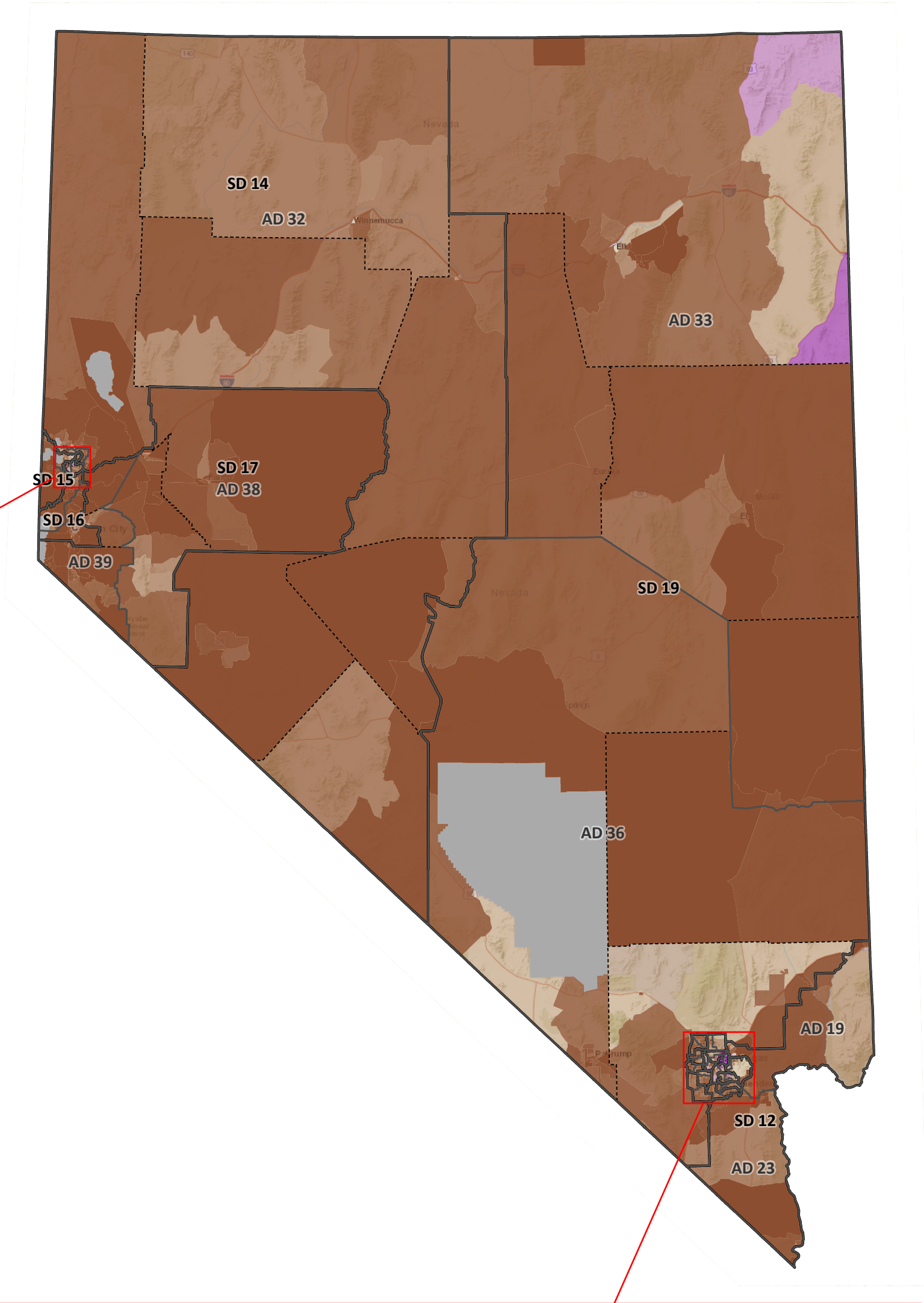
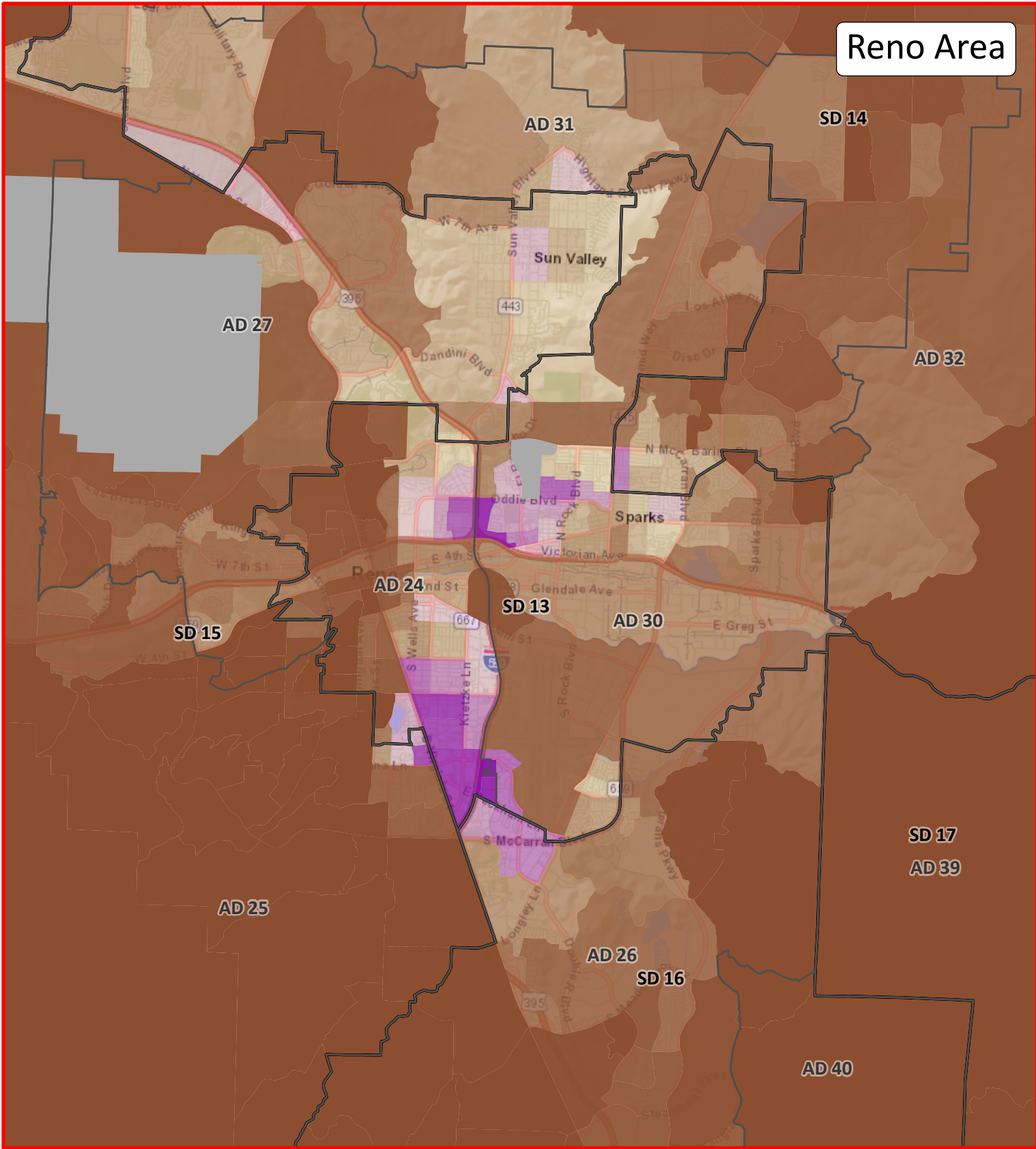


PREDOMINANT ETHNICITY IN NEVADA BY CENSUS BLOCK GROUP

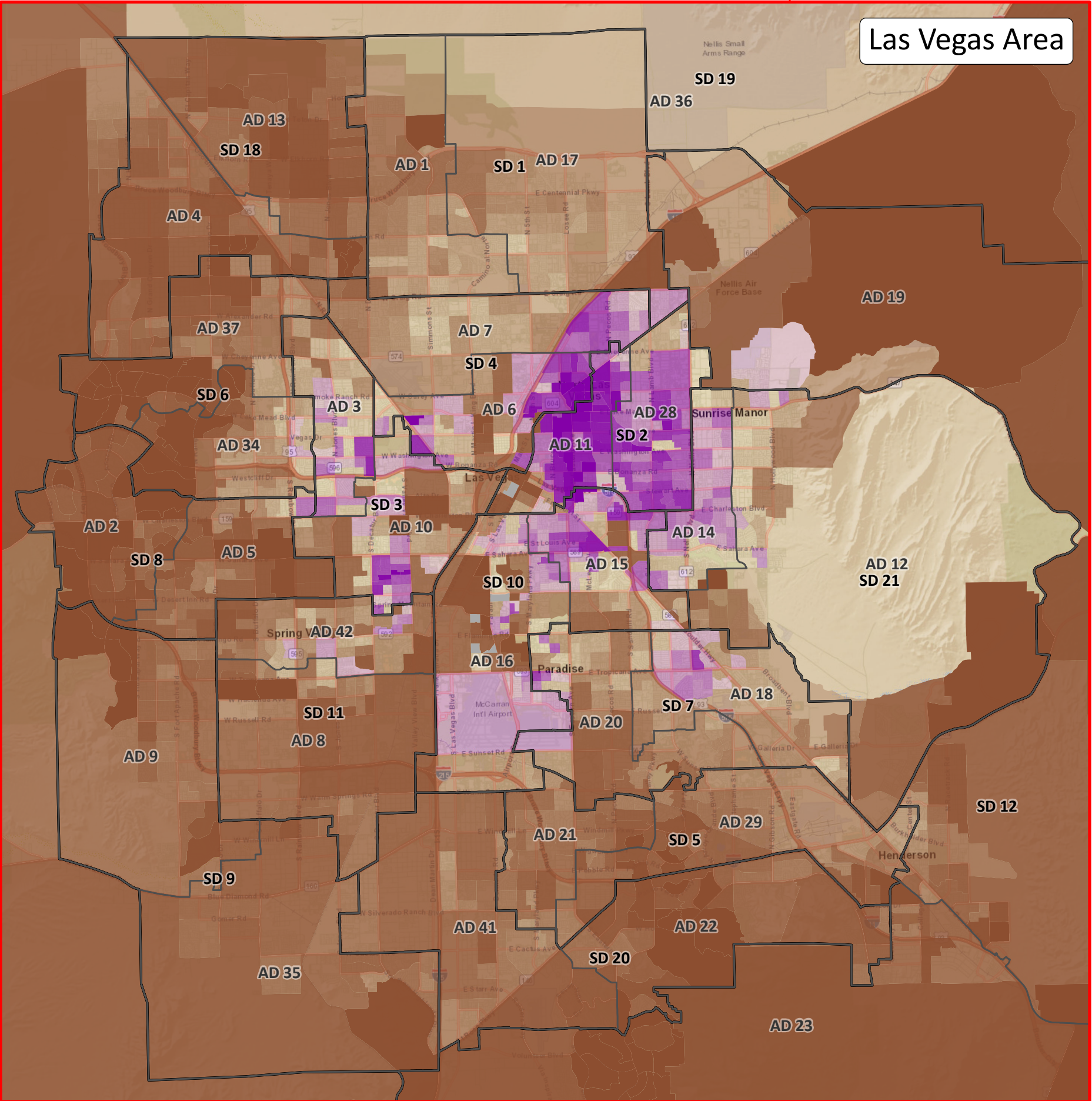

Predominance mapping shows which category is greater in number out of all possible categories, and by how much, for a geographical area. This map shows which census block groups have a predominantly Hispanic or Latino population and which do not have a population that is predominantly Hispanic or Latino. Darker colors indicate a higher relative strength of predominance for the majority ethnicity, while lighter colors indicate the majority ethnicity has just a slightly higher population than the other.

Notes: The population database is derived from Esri's 2020 Updated Demographics estimates (which include data sources from the U.S. Census Bureau American Community Survey, administrative records, and private sources) and validated by the Legislative Council Bureau. Ethnicity data is based on self-identification. A person of Hispanic or Latino Origin is of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin regardless of race.
