


## PREDOMINANT RACE IN NEVADA BY CENSUS BLOCK GROUP

2020 Census Data







Predominance mapping shows which category is greater in number out of all possible categories for a geographical area and by how much. This map shows which race is predominant, or holds the majority, out of all races for each census block group. Darker colors indicate a higher relative strength of predominance for the majority race, while lighter colors indicate the majority race has just a slightly higher population than other races.

Notes: The population database is derived from the 2020 Census Public Law 94-171 Redistricting Data as provided by the U.S. Census Bureau and validated by the Legislative Counsel Bureau. Racial population data is based on self-identification and respondents have



the option of selecting one or more races. Hispanic Origin is not included because it is defined as a language group, separate from race.
