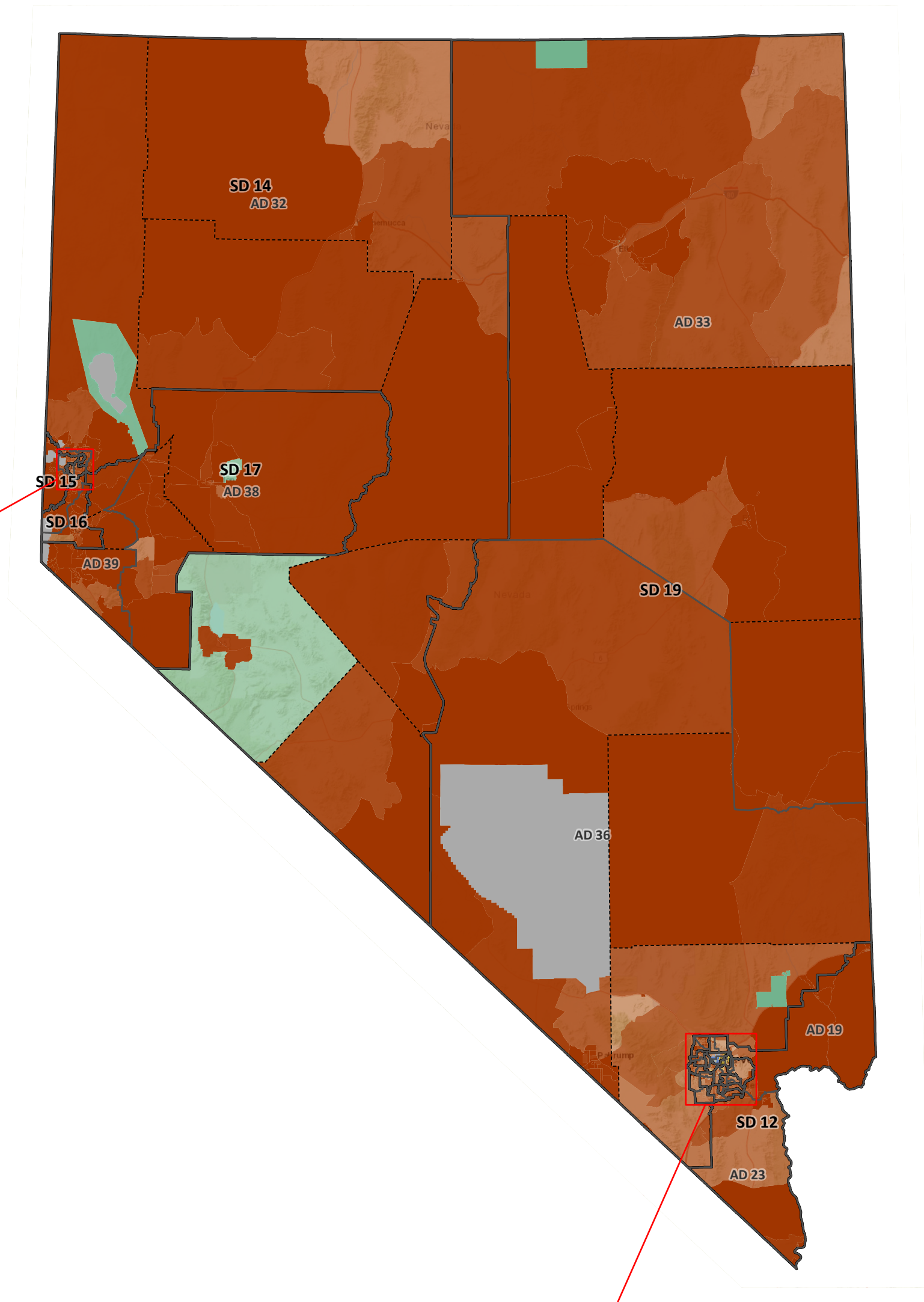
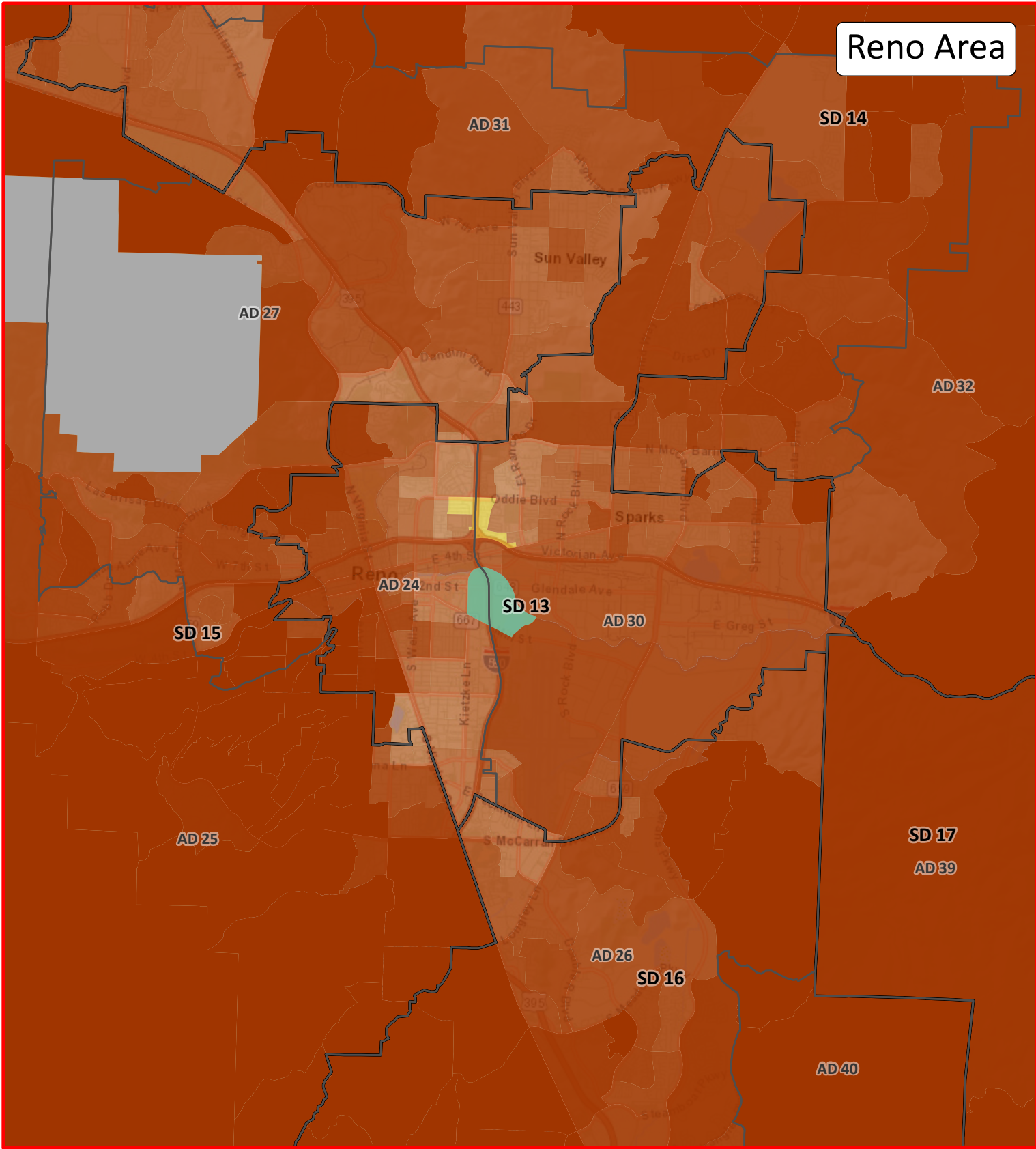


PREDOMINANT RACE IN NEVADA BY CENSUS BLOCK GROUP

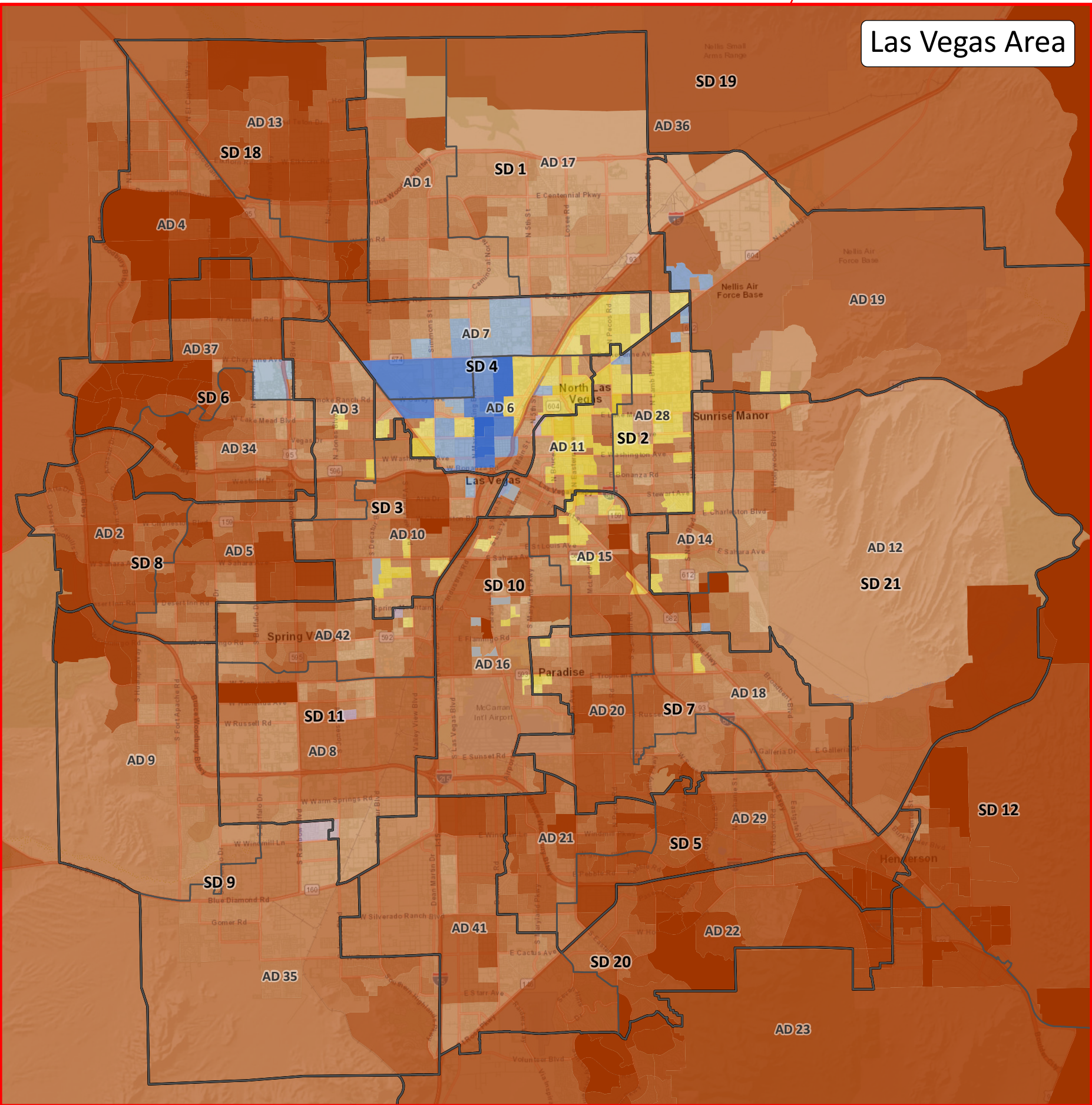

Predominance mapping shows which category is greater in number out of all possible categories for a geographical area and by how much. This map shows which race is predominant, or holds the majority, out of all races for each census block group. Darker colors indicate a higher relative strength of predominance for the majority race, while lighter colors indicate the majority race has just a slightly higher population than other races.

Notes: The population database is derived from Esri's 2020 Updated Demographics estimates (which include data sources from the U.S. Census Bureau American Community Survey, administrative records, and private sources) and validated by the Legislative Counsel Bureau. Racial population data is based on self-identification and respondents have the option of selecting one or more races. Hispanic Origin is not included because it is defined as a language group, not a race category.
