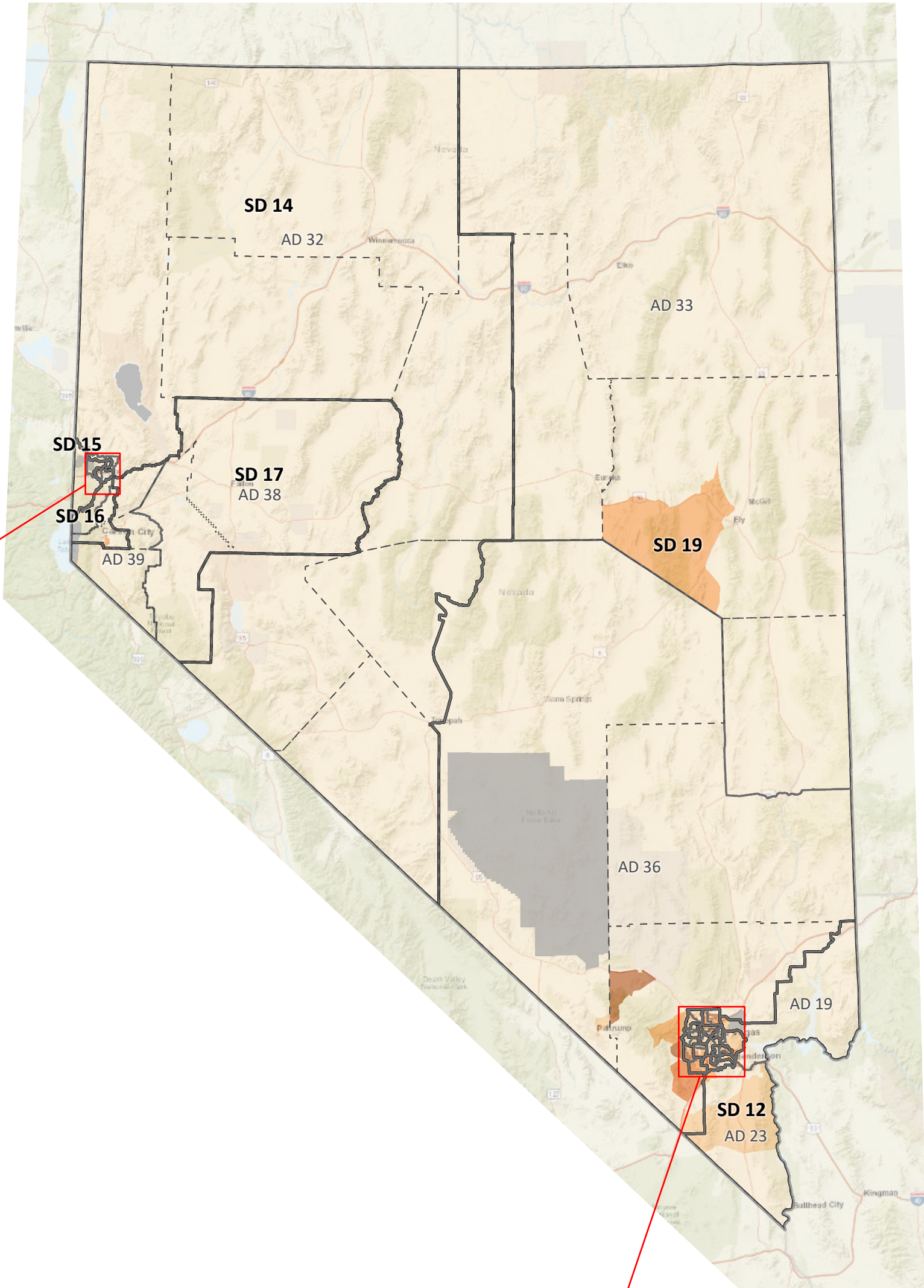
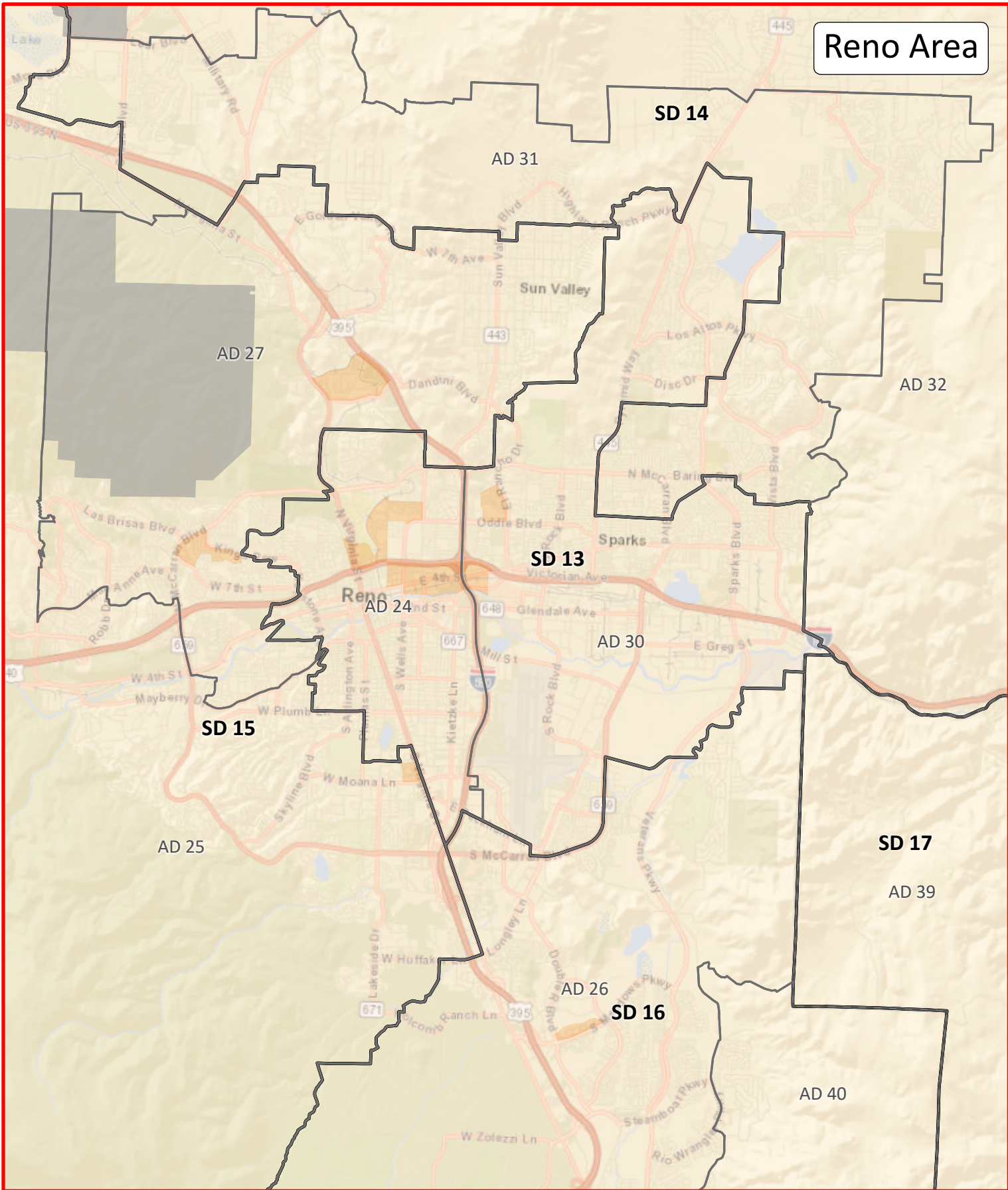


NEVADA DEMOGRAPHICS BY CENSUS BLOCK GROUP

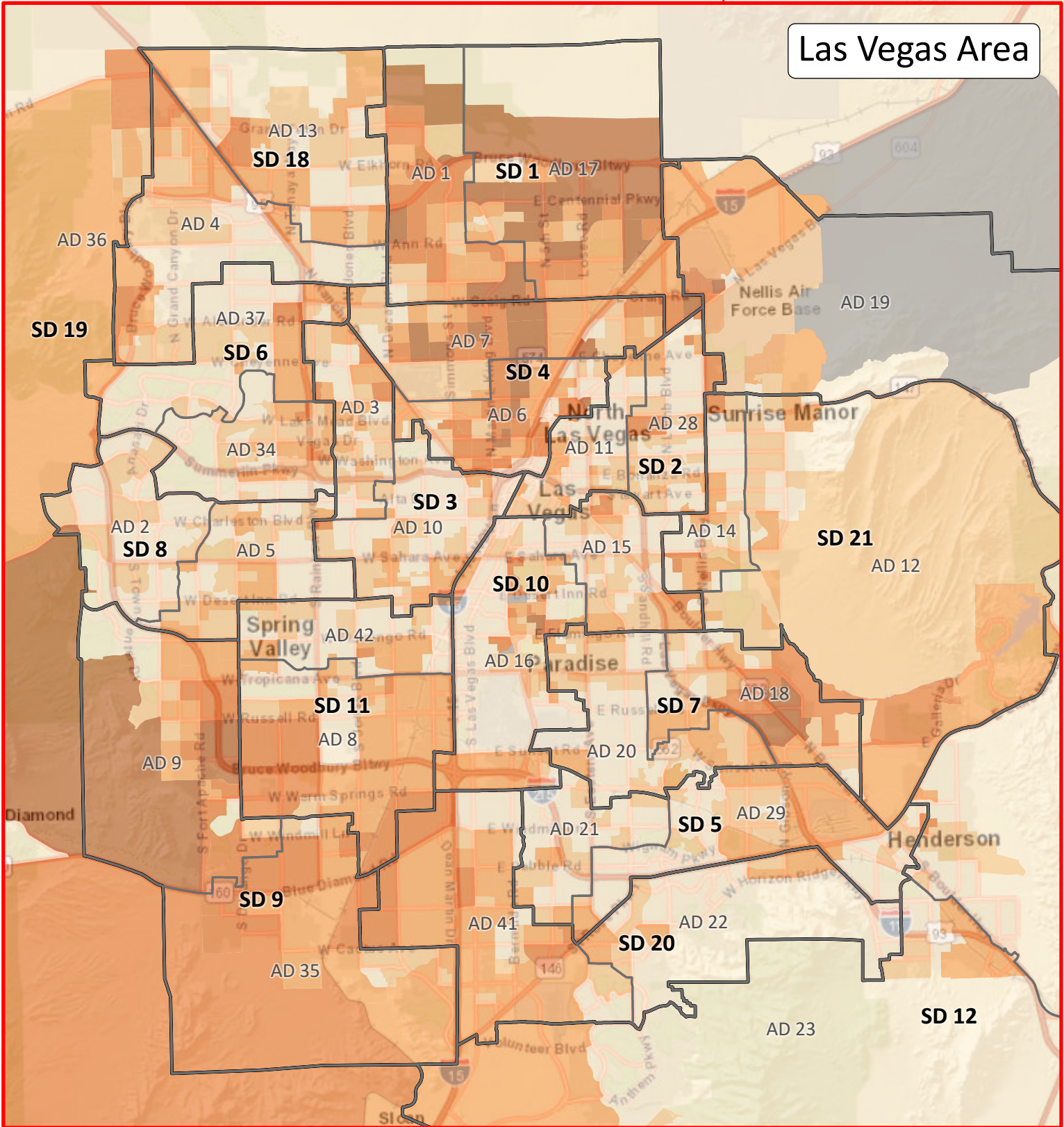
