To obtain ESRI's 2020 Updated Demographics estimates for each NSHE Regent district, data was downloaded at the census block group level and aggregated by the district boundary. This is not a perfect method, as some block groups are not contained wholly within a district. For block groups that were split across NSHE Regent district boundaries, their data was apportioned among intersecting districts by the percentage of its geographic area contained in each district. One limitation to this method is that it assumes population types are evenly distributed throughout a block group, which may not necessarily be the case.
