



Interim Expenditure Report for Assembly Bill 525 (AB525)

Puentes is a 501 (c)(3), nonprofit community-based organization focused on reducing systemic and structural inequity through the development of sustainable support and services which improve the social determinants of health in the communities we serve. We serve communities at a higher risk for poor outcomes due to the barriers they experience to social, economic, political and environmental resources.

In the first three quarters of 2024, Puentes conducted over 450 outreach events, all within our most vulnerable communities. These outreach engagements generated an estimated 96,497 impressions, that is, unique individuals exposed to our messaging. The AB525 funding allowed Puentes to continue these outreach events at a time where fundraising has been very difficult.

During these engagements we fielded 6,143 requests for assistance that included housing, food support, medical care, Medicaid and Medicare benefits, victim advocacy, parental support and other critical social determinants of health. Our website recorded 10,885 sessions where individuals were able to get assistance directly through our Resource Wizard. Of those, 295 requests were elevated for further information/assistance.

An additional 1,115 requests came by telephone, all of which would have either been handled by our bilingual operators or referred to others on our team for more comprehensive intervention. Remarkably, our Social Worker managed 1,747 complex cases involving multiple needs, often under traumatic circumstances.

Our outreach methods are designed to provide service with the cultural and conditional knowledge necessary to overcome fear, distrust and other barriers that have contributed to longstanding inequities within marginalized populations. Our methods recognize that one approach does not fit all communities, but the best approach begins by listening to the community's needs and concerns, acknowledging fears and historical injustices then developing solutions contextualized to the community.

The organization received the appropriated \$10,000 from State Assembly Bill 525 in late 2023. As of November 30, 2024, Puentes has expended \$8,966.99 (90%) of the funds on programmatic staff salaries. The attached summary and detail reports reflect how Puentes utilized the funds provided through AB525.
