Dr. James W. Guthrie is the State of Nevada Superintendent of Public Instruction and a senior fellow at the George W. Bush Institute, a component of the George W. Bush Presidential Center. He previously served as a professor of education policy and leadership in the Annette Caldwell Simmons School and Human Development at Southern Methodist University. Prior to that, Dr. Guthrie was the Patricia and Rodes Hart Professor of Educational Leadership and Policy and Director of the Peabody Center for Education Policy at the Peabody College of Education and Human Development at Vanderbilt University. Previously a professor at the University of California, Berkeley, Dr. Guthrie holds a B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. from Stanford University, and undertook postdoctoral study in public finance at Harvard.

H. Pepper Sturm is the Chief Deputy Research Director of the Research Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB). He has worked for the Legislature since 1987, serving as staff to committees dealing with educational topics and issues relating to labor, the legislature, and social services. Mr. Sturm is currently staff to the Senate Committee on Education. He has a master's degree in library science from the University of North Texas and a bachelor's degree in English from the University of Nevada, Reno.
